






AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 6250.(a) AND TO  
REPEAL AND REENACT A NEW SECTION 6252,  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO  
DISBURSING AND CERTIFYING OFFICERS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 6250.(a) of the Government Code of  
3 Guam is hereby amended to read:

4 "Section 6250. Definitions. (a). Certifying  
5 Officers shall mean the chief executive officer of  
6 a department, establishment or agency of the government  
7 of Guam, including the Legislative, Executive and  
8 Judicial Branches, and all autonomous and semi-autonomous  
9 agencies, who shall be responsible for determining  
10 and certifying legality of the disbursement of public  
11 funds."

12 Section 2. Section 6252 of the Government Code of Guam  
13 is hereby repealed and reenacted to read:

14 "Section 6252. Certifying Officers: delegation.  
15 The Certifying Officer may delegate his authority to  
16 determine and certify the legality of the disbursement  
17 of public funds but final responsibility for certification  
18 shall remain with the Certifying Officer. Whenever  
19 the Certifying Officer delegates his authority he  
20 shall, within ten (10) days after such an appointment,  
1 file a copy of the appointment with the Disbursing  
2 Officer for the department, establishment or agency,  
3 the Director of Administration and with the Territorial  
4 Auditor, the name and position of the officer or employee  
5 appointed by him."
