

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9705.1(z) OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE, CITED AS THE GUAM FOOD, DRUG, AND COSMETIC ACT, RELATIVE TO THE DEFINITION OF 'PULL DATE', TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (AA) TO SECTION 9705.1 OF THE SAME CODE TO DEFINE 'PACK DATE' AND TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (16) TO SECTION 9705.9 OF THE SAME CODE RELATIVE TO PACKDATING OF LOCALLY AND/OR PROCESSED FOOD.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 9705.1(z) of the Government Code,  
3 cited as the Guam Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, is hereby amended  
4 to read as follows:

5 "Section 9705.1(z). The term 'pull date' means the  
6 calendar date printed by the manufacturer on the package  
7 or wrapping which represents the date after which the  
8 manufacturer recommends that the product not be sold.

9 Section 2. A new subsection (aa) is hereby added to  
10 Section 9705.1 of the Government Code, after subsection (z),  
11 to read as follows:

12 "Section 9705.1(aa). The term 'pack date' means the  
13 complete date (month in letters, day, and year in numbers)  
14 printed by the manufacturer on the package, which represents  
15 the date the product has been produced and packaged."

16 Section 3. A new subsection (16) is hereby added to Section  
17 9705.9 of the Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

18 "Section 9705.9 (16). If any locally packaged and/or  
19 processed food bears no calendar date indicating the 'pack  
20 date' written in English and which is easily legible and  
21 visible to the consumer."
