






Bill No. 30

Introduced by E. R. Duenas

AN ACT TRANSFERRING THE JURISDICTION
OF THE BASEBALL FIELD SITUATED ADJACENT
TO THE WETTENGEL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN
THE MUNICIPALITY OF DEDEDO FROM THE
DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO THE DEPARTMENT
OF PARKS AND RECREATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

1 Section 1. That portion of Lot No. 5171 being used as a
2 baseball field situated adjacent to the Wettengel Elementary
3 School in the Municipality of Dededo is hereby transferred from
4 the Department of Education over to the Department of Parks and
5 Recreation.

7 Section 2. The Department of Parks and Recreation shall
8 cooperate fully with the Department of Education and the Office
9 of the Commissioner of Dededo in the implementation of sports
10 activities on this field.

11 Section 3. A new Section 11503 is added to the Government
12 Code to read:

13 "Section 11503. School Recreational Facilities:

14 (a) The Board of Education may grant permission for
15 the use of school recreational facilities. The Commissioner
16 of each such village shall make written request to the Board
17 of Education for the use of such school facilities. The
18 Commissioner shall act as liaison with the Board for schedul-
19 ing and supervision of such facilities.

20 (b) The Board shall prescribe such rules and regulations
21 relating to the use of the school recreational facilities

1 as it may deem necessary. Persons using the school
2 recreational facilities shall be liable for any damage done
3 over and above ordinary wear. Neither the government of
4 Guam nor the Board of Education shall be liable for damage
5 or injury to person or property suffered by any person
6 resulting from dangerous or defective condition of the
7 school recreational facilities while such person was
8 present under permission granted by the Board."

9 Section 4. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
