CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

Bill No. 221, "An Act to make an appropriation of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) for the purpose of funding the Fourteenth Guam Legislature's Select Committee on Police Corruption and for other purposes", was passed by the Legislature on April 15, 1977. On April 19th, the Governor of Guam signed Bill No. 221 into law and it was denominated Public Law 14-20. When the Governor signed into law, he reduced the appropriation in Section 1 to zero and returned said bill to the Legislature with the reduction endorsed on the face of it. This is to certify that said Section 1 has been reconsidered by the Legislature and after such reconsideration the Legislature did, on the 26th day of April, 1977, agree to pass said Section 1 of Bill No. 221 (Public Law 14-20) notwithstanding the Governor's objection, by a vote of two-thirds of all the members hereof to wit: by a vote of 16 members.

Bill No. 221

Introduced by J. M. Rivera

AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION OF ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE FOURTEENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE'S SELECT COMMITTEE ON POLICE CORRUPTION AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated and to be trans-
3 ferred to the Legislature Operations Fund from any available
4 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
5 sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) for the purpose
6 of funding the Fourteenth Guam Legislature's Select Committee
7 on Police Corruption as created pursuant to Resolution No. 22
8 duly and regularly adopted on February 7, 1977.

9 Section 2. Such sums as shall have been expended from the
10 Fourteenth Guam Legislature's Central Operations Fund for
11 expenses incurred by the Select Committee on Police Corruption
12 created by Resolution No. 22, shall be charged against the
13 appropriation made by Section 1 of this Act.

14 Section 3. The sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) is
15 hereby appropriated from any Unappropriated Surplus of the
16 General Fund to the Department of Education for the purpose of
17 sending the members of the joint Vocational Technical-George
18 Washington High Schools Army J.R.O.T.C. drill team to partici-
19 pate in the competition to be held at Honolulu beginning
20 April 20, 1977.

1 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available
2 fund of the General Fund the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars
3 (\$15,000.00) to pay for the cost of officiating games in the
4 Guam Little League and Guam Babe Ruth League for the 1977
5 Season. Said appropriation shall be made to the Department of
6 Parks and Recreation.

7 Section 5. This Act shall be effective upon its enactment.
