

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 16433 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO EXEMPT
FROM EXAMINATION THOSE PERSONS ENGAGED
IN THE PRACTICE OF COSMETOLOGY IN GUAM
PRIOR TO JANUARY 26, 1972.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 16433 is hereby added to the Government
3 Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 16433. Exemption for prior licenses.

5 Persons engaged in activities requiring licensing under
6 the provisions of this Chapter that were so engaged in
7 Guam prior to January 26, 1972, shall be exempted from the
8 examination requirements hereof."
