AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 16433 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO EXEMPT FROM EXAMINATION THOSE PERSONS ENGAGED IN THE PRACTICE OF COSMETOLOGY IN GUAM PRIOR TO JANUARY 26, 1972.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 16433 is hereby added to the Government

Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 16433. Exemption for prior licenses.

Persons engaged in activities requiring licensing under the provisions of this Chapter that were so engaged in Guam prior to January 26, 1972, shall be exempted from the examination requirements hereof."
