Notwithstanding any provisions of law, 12 rules or regulations to the contrary, the appropriations 13 made for the Fire Operations Bureau for personal services 14 under Section 3.II.B. of this Act and Section 1 of Public 15 Law 13-149 may be used for retroactive compensation to 16 firemen to satisfy the requirements of Public Law 12-183. 17 Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from any 18 available belance in the General Fund and to be transferred 19 to the Legislature's Operations Fund the sum of Seventy-Five 20 Thousand Dollars (875,000) for the purpose of funding the 21 Yourteenth Guam Legislature's project on Yederal Landtakings. 22 Section 7. The amount appropriated under Section 23 3. II.A.1 of this Act consists of One Hundred Twenty-Hight 24 Thousand Five Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$128,520) of LEAA 25 funds and the amount appropriated under Section 4 includes 26 Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000) of LEAA funds. 27 Section 8. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary the 28 statute of limitations relative to the Government Claims 29 Fund shall be waived until September 30, 1977 for the sole 30 purpose of allowing those persons awad overtime payments 31 prior to the effective date of this Act by the government of 32 Guam to file claims. Such claims shall be paid out of said 33 fund if found to be meritorious. 34
