


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 26017.1 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE THAT
PERSONS SIXTY YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER
SHALL BE ADMITTED FREE OF CHARGE TO RE-
CREATIONAL EVENTS AND GAMES SPONSORED BY
THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 26017.1 is hereby added to the Govern-
3 ment Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 26017.1. Admission of older residents free
5 of charge. All residents of Guam sixty (60) years of age
6 or older shall be admitted free of charge to those games,
7 entertainments, or other recreational activities sponsored
8 by the Department of Parks and Recreation or by any other
9 department or agency of the government of Guam. When the
10 Department of Parks and Recreation or any other department
11 or agency enters into an agreement with a private sports
12 or entertainment club or association for the use of facili-
13 ties belonging to the government of Guam, one of the terms
14 of such agreement must be that such residents of Guam sixty
15 (60) years of age or older be so admitted free of charge to
16 the game, games, or other activity the subject of such
17 contract; provided, however, that when the association
18 seeking use of the facilities itself is composed of older
19 residents and those expected to patronize the facilities
20 are also older residents, then the provisions of this
21 Section shall not apply. The Director of Parks and Recrea-
22 tion shall establish rules and regulations to accomplish the
23 purpose of this Section."
