AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE LOCAL FUNDS FROM CERTAIN HIGHWAY PROJECTS AND TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF FDAA SUPPORT AS LOCAL MATCH FOR FEDERAL FUNDS AND TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE TERRITORIAL HIGHWAY FUND FOR CONSTRUCTION AND DESIGN OF CERTAIN HIGHWAY PROJECTS IN 1977 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAME

Section 1. The unexpended balance of local funds totaling \$254,614 from the following projects are hereby reverted to the Unappropriated Surplus of the Territorial Highway Fund for use as local contribution to match federal funds made available to Guam under the Federal Highway Act of 1970 for highway construction:

Section 2. The Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to apply \$200,000 of the flexible funds approved by the FDAA for the government of Guam, to match FHWA funds for highway construction.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the Territorial Highway Fund the sum of \$4,812,537 including \$3,262,677 in FHWA funds for the following projects:

Section 4. Any unexpended balance of funds appropriated pursuant to Section 25 of Public Law 13-103 is hereby transferred to the Committee on Territorial-Federal Affairs.

Section 5. Subparagraph (a) of Section 4086.2 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) Annual leave period shall be granted employees

occupying permanent positions, except personnel of the

Department of Education who are employed on a school-year

basis, in accordance with the following schedule:

1. One-half day (4 hours) for each full bi-weekly

pay period in the case of employees with less than

three (3) years of service.

2. Three-fourths day (6 hours) for each bi-weekly

pay period except that the accrual for the last full

- 2. Three-fourths day (6 hours) for each bi-weekly pay period except that the accrual for the last full bi-weekly pay period in the year shall be one and one-fourth day (10 hours) in the case of employees with three (3) but less than fifteen (15) years of service.
- 3. One day for each full bi-weekly pay period in the case of employees with fifteen (15) years or more service.

For purposes of this Section, all elected employees except Senators shall be deemed employees occupying permanent positions."

Section 6. The amendment of Section 4006.2 of the Gevernment Code of Guam as made by Section 5 of this Act is not deemed to be a change in existing law but a codification of administrative practice approved by the Legislature from the commencement of civil government in 1950. The opinion of the Attorney General of Guam, dated December 19, 1973, on the subject of annual leave for commissioners, is hereby ratified and approved by the Legislature.

Section 7. There is hereby appropriated from any available 1 balance in the Territorial Highway Fund the sum of Seventy-Five 2 Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) for construction of the unfinished 3 portion of the Canada-Toto road, including relocation of waterlines affected by the road construction as shown in the Department 5 of Public Works map, drawing No. HW/206-72. 6 Section 8. There is hereby appropriated from any available 7 balance in the General Fund the sum of Two Hundred Fifty-Two 8 Thousand Dollars (\$252,000) to supplement the appropriation made 9 by Section 1 of P. L. 13-149 to the Department of Public Safety 10 Fire Operations Bureau for Personal Services. 11 Section 9. There is hereby appropriated from any available 12 balance in the General Fund the sum of Six Thousand Dollars 13 (\$6,000) to upgrade the Tumon baseball field. 14 Section 10. There is hereby appropriated from any available 15 balance in the General Fund the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand 16 Dollars (\$25,000) to be transferred to the fund established by 17 Section 17 of this Act. 18 Section 11. There is hereby appropriated from any available 19 balance of the General Fund the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars 20 (\$10,000) to the Guam Commission on the Status of Women to 21 organize and conduct a Guam Women's Conference on Guam and to send 22 delegates to Houston, Texas for the National Wemen's Conference. 23 Section 12. There is hereby appropriated from any available 24 balance in the General Fund the sum of One Million Six Hundred 25 Thousand Dollars (\$1,600,000) to the Department of Education for 26

(a) There is established in 27 the Treasury of Guam the 'sports fund for off-island 28 travel'. The fund shall be managed by the Director. The 29 Department Certifying Officer shall be the Certifying 30 31 Officer for the fund.

The fund is to be expended to provide grants (b) 1 for transportation expenses for off-island travel by 2 civilian sports organizations and individuals. 3 The grants shall be used for a maximum of fifty percent (50%) of transportation expenses of team members 5 and coaches for competitions in sports events such as 6 regional, national and international tournaments. 7 (d) Youth organizations shall be given preference in 8 the awarding of grants. 9 (e) The Commission shall promulgate regulations to 10 establish procedures for application for grants, priorities 11 of funding, limitations by type of sport and event on the 12 number of team members or coaches supported by the grant 13 and other necessary procedures for making the grants. 14 (f) The Commission shall review all applications and 15 make the grants and may impose conditions for expenditure. 16 The Director shall then disburse the grant to a representative 17 of the organization prior to the departure of the grantees. 18 The representative of the recipient organization 19 shall provide the Director with an accurate accounting 20 of expenditure of all funds for air transportation within 21 thirty (30) days of returning to Guam. If the report is 22 not completed and filed within thirty (30) days or if 23 there is a misuse of funds in the opinion of the Commission, 24 the organization shall not receive further grants from the 25 fund and shall reimburse the fund in an amount determined 26 by the Commission. 27 - 10 -

(h) The Director shall make an annual report to the Governor and the Legislature on June 30th of each year which shall include the information: number of applications, number and amounts of grants actually made, and other data concerning the management of the fund.

(i) Any person who wilfully misuses a grant received under this Section shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and subject to a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Bollars (\$500)."
