

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATION FOR THE YOUTH
CONSERVATION CORPS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of One
3 Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000) for the Youth
4 Conservation Corps Program in Calendar Year 1977, to include the
5 sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) from the General
6 Fund, to serve as local matching funds for One Hundred Thousand
7 Dollars (\$100,000) in Federal Funds.

8 Section 2. The appropriation made in Section 1 shall not
9 be construed as limiting the amounts of federal monies that may
10 be received for this program; provided, however, that no additional
11 local funds may be committed as conditional to their receipt.

12 Section 3. No amount of the local portion of the appropria-
13 tion made in Section 1 shall be expended until such time that
14 awarding on the federal funds is certain.

1 Section 4. The Director of Agriculture shall submit a report
2 to the Speaker of the Legislature no later than September 1, 1977.
3 Said report shall include a statement of expenditures from the
4 appropriation made in Section 1 of this Act and shall include a
5 statement regarding the programs goals and accomplishments, number
6 of active participants and recommendations for improvement of
7 the program in the future as may be warranted.

8 Section 5. All unexpended balances remaining as of September
9 15, 1977 from the appropriation made in Section 1 of this Act
10 is hereby returned to the General Fund or shall be or shall caused
11 to be reimbursed to the Federal Government in the same proportion
12 as appropriated.

13 Section 6. The Youth Conservation Corps Program shall be
14 administered in accordance with federal guidelines established
15 for the program and such other rules and procedures as may be
16 adopted.
