

AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS  
FOR THE OPERATION OF VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS AND  
AGENCIES OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH FOR THE FISCAL  
YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1977, AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The balance of Three Million Five Hundred  
3 Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000) of the appropriation made by  
4 Section 15 (a) of Public Law 12-150 for Guam International  
5 Air Terminal capital improvements and other projects is hereby  
6 reverted to the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to  
7 satisfy the appropriations made by Sections 2 and 4 of this Act.

8 Section 2. The following sums are hereby appropriated  
9 from any available balance in the General Fund to supplement  
10 the appropriations made by Part One, Section 1 of Public Law  
11 13-149 for the operation of the following agencies for the  
12 fiscal year ending June 30, 1977:

13 I. Community Services

14 A. Department of Public Health & Social Services

15 1. Social Services Division

16 a. Miscellaneous --Medicaid \$1,296,000

17 II. Public Health

18 A. Guam Memorial Hospital

19 1. Contribution to the Guam

20 Memorial Hospital Operations Fund \$ 430,872

1           III.    Education

2                A.    University of Guam

3                    1.    Utilities

4                      a.    Water/Sewer	\$    44,294
5                      b.    Telephone	\$    20,000

6                Section 3.    The sum appropriated under Section 2.I.A.1.a.  
7 of this Act for Medicaid includes Six Hundred Forty-Eight  
8 Thousand Dollars (\$648,000) in Federal Grants-in-Aid.

9                Section 4.    There is hereby appropriated from any available  
10 balance in the General Fund the sum of Two Hundred Thousand  
11 Dollars (\$200,000) to the Guam Legislature's Operations Fund  
12 for the purpose of conducting the annual audit of the accounts  
13 and financial transactions of the government of Guam for the  
14 fiscal year ending June 30, 1977 and other special audits as  
15 the Legislature may determine necessary.

16               Section 5.    Notwithstanding any provisions of law, rules  
17 or regulations to the contrary, the sums appropriated in Section  
18 2 of this Act may be used to pay off obligations incurred prior  
19 to fiscal year 1977; provided however, that such payments are  
20 for supplies and services identified in this Act.
