AN ACT TO ADD NEW SECTION 10258 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE  
RELATIVE TO PRESERVATION OF HIGHWAYS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new §10258 is added to the Government Code to read:

"§10258. Repairs: Requirements.

(a) No person, firm or corporation shall engage in any repair work on any primary or secondary roads or other improved roadways paved with asphaltic concrete having a thickness of one inch or more without first having obtained approval from, or certification by, the Director of Public Works or his authorized designee. The purpose of this requirement is to insure quality repair work equal to that required in the original bid specifications.

(b) The Director or his authorized designee shall promulgate the necessary implementing rules and regulations, including the establishment of criteria for the approval or certification of contractors to perform repair work on roadways in Guam.

(c) In the issuance of approval or certification of contractors the Director or his authorized designee shall require the posting of bonds in such amounts as the department may deem sufficient to ensure proper compliance with the provisions of this Section, provided no fees shall be required for certification."
