




Bill No. 278

Introduced by K. B. Aguon

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 11119 AND
TO AMEND SECTION 6500.1(b) OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE TO PROVIDE FOR THE MEANS
FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO USE
VOLUNTEER HELP, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE
DEPARTMENT TO OBTAIN LIABILITY INSURANCE
FOR SAID VOLUNTEERS AND TO INCLUDE SAID
VOLUNTEERS WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE
GOVERNMENT CLAIMS ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Section 11119 is added to the Government
Code to read:

"Section 11119. Volunteers in Education. The Board
is authorized to institute a program within the Department
of Education to be entitled 'Volunteers in Education'. The
Board shall by its policies make needful rules and regula-
tions for the utilization of said volunteers in Education
within the department. The Board is authorized to obtain
liability insurance coverage for said volunteers."

Section 2. Section 6500.1(b) of the Government Code is
amended to read:

"Section 6500.1. (b) For claims in tort, arising
from the negligent acts of its employees, or volunteers
acting for and at the direction of the government, even
though occurring in an activity in which private persons do
not engage.

The government shall not be liable for claims arising
from an exercise of discretion in making policy."

Section 3. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated
Surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Education the
sum of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000) for the purpose of erecting
a score board at the John F. Kennedy and George Washington Senior
High Schools football field.
