AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 4104.1, OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO PROVIDE A PAY INCREASE FOR THOSE EMPLOYEES WHO HAVE BEEN AT STEP 10 OF THE PAY RANGES FOR THREE YEARS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM! Section 1. A new Section 4104.1 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 4104.1. The rules and regulations referred to in Section 4104 shall provide that an employee who is at step 10 for three (3) consecutive years and has served satisfactorily shall have his work record reviewed and if it is found to be satisfactory, then he shall have his pay adjusted to Step 10 in the next highest pay range." Section 2. A new Section 4106.2 is added to the Government Code of Guam to read:

"Section 4106.2. Within the Department of Public Health and Social Services the following classified positions are created and given annual compensation as follows:

SALARY POSITION

\$28,000 - \$31,000 General Practitioner

Physician Specialist (Board eligible)\$32,000 - \$31,000

Physician Specialist (Board approved) \$36,000 - \$39,000."

Section 3. Persons who on June 30, 1977 had contracts with the Department of Public Health and Social Services for provision of professional medical services may be employed by the Department in regular positions without complying with statutory provisions, rules or regulations relating to appointment of employees. In carrying out the Administrative Provisions of Public Law 14-43 it is the clear intention of the Legislature to authorize the filling of positions which contribute to the health or safety of Guam residents and other positions which are essential or otherwise critical to the operation of the government. It is the simple intention of Item IV.G of Part III of Public Law 14-43 to distontinue the practice of using special contracts and consultant contracts to fill regular positions in government of Guam service and to require instead that the merit system and the personnel laws be fully implemented.

Section 4. Sections 2 and 3 of this Act are retroactive in its effect to July 1, 1977.

Section 5. Section 2 of Public Law 10-195, as amended by Public Law 14-41, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law (including the provision of Chapter 6, Title XIV of the Government Code of Guam) with respect to the sale of government land, the Governor is authorized to sell lets in the Pagachao Subdivision in Agat, Pigua Subdivision in Merizo, and the Umatac Subdivision in Umatac at less than fair market value of the lots and at less than the cost expended by the government of Guam in developing and improving said lets, but not to exceed the amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500) for each lot."

Section 6. (a) Part I, Section 1, VIII., A., 2., of Public Law 14-43 is amended to read:

"2. Parks Division

(b) Part I, Section 1, VIII., A., 3., of Public Law 14-43 is amended to read:

Recreation Division

a.	Personal Services	\$309,418

c.	Contractual Services	\$ 10,400
d.	Supplies & Materials	\$ 27,067
e.	Equipment	\$ 11,560

(c) The transfer of appropriation made in this Section shall be for the purpose of restoring to the Recreation Division the position, Parks and Recreation Coordinator (#P-749) and delinesting the position, Parks and Maintenance Foreman in the Parks Division."

Section 7. There is hereby added a new Subsection (c) to Section 11101 of the Government Code to read:

"(c) The Department of Education may employ an attorney to assist and represent it in all civil matters which concern the Department. The Attorney General shall represent the Department in all litigation in which the Department is interested, provided that the Attorney General shall designate the Attorney for the Department as a Special Assistant Attorney General for this purpose.

The Department of Education may set the terms and conditions of employment for the Attorney, his compensation and whether he be appointed as a full-time employee, an independent consultant, or may utilize the services of a law firm.

б

The attorney so employed, or engaged, shall be admitted to practice before the courts of Guam under the same conditions as are attorneys employed by the government pursuant to Section 28002.2 of the Government Code."

Section 8. The attorney holding the position authorized in Section 11101 (c) of the Government Code shall be compensated entirely from Federal funds for fiscal year ending June 30, 1978.

Section 9. Notwithstanding any provisions of law, rules or regulations to the contrary, balances available on June 30, 1977 of Federal Grants-in-Aid and their required local matching share appropriated under Public Law 13-149 are hereby reappropriated for the same purposes and objects and to be carried forward past June 30, 1977, the closing date of the fiscal year for government of Guam, to September 30, 1977, the closing date of the fiscal year for the Federal government. Provided further that this Section shall not be construed as an additional appropriation.
