

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

This is to certify that Substitute Bill No. 572, "An Act making a supplemental appropriation to the Bureau of Planning to increase its operations budget for Fiscal Year 1978, to include and authorize for expenditure of a new Federal Grant-In-Aid Program, 'Title 15 - Coastal Energy Impact Program Catalog No. 11-41' and for other purposes" returned to the Legislature without the approval of the Governor was, in accordance with the Organic Act of Guam, reconsidered by the Legislature and after such reconsideration the Legislature did on the 8th day of December, 1977, agree to pass said bill notwithstanding the objections of the Governor by a vote of two-thirds of all the members thereof, to wit: by a vote of 18 members.

AN ACT MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO
THE BUREAU OF PLANNING TO INCREASE ITS OPERATIONS
BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1978, TO INCLUDE AND
AUTHORIZE FOR EXPENDITURE OF A NEW FEDERAL
GRANT-IN-AID PROGRAM, "TITLE 15 - COASTAL ENERGY
IMPACT PROGRAM CATALOG NO. 11-41" AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Part I, Section 1, I., D., d. of Public Law 14-43,
3 as amended, is amended to read:

4 "d. Contractual Services \$109,517"

5 Section 2. Part I, Section 1, XIV., D., of Public Law 14-43,
6 as amended, is amended by adding new Item 3. to read:

7 "3. Coastal Energy Impact

8 Program 11-41 \$ 16,556"

9 Section 3. The Bureau of Planning is authorized to receive
10 and spend for the purpose and within the scope of federal grant
11 requirements for "Title 15 - Coastal Energy Impact Program
12 Catalog No. 11-41". The Bureau of Planning is authorized to
13 act as grantor and the Guam Energy Office as sub-grantee. The
14 Guam Energy Office is authorized to use a portion of its fiscal
15 year 1978 appropriation for local in-kind matching in the amount
16 of Four Thousand One Hundred Thirty-Nine Dollars (\$4,139).

1 Section 4. There is appropriated from any available balance
2 in the General Fund the sum of One Million Five Hundred Thousand
3 Dollars (\$1,500,000) to the Guam Economic Development Authority
4 for the purpose of the Authority making a loan to the Medical
5 Center of the Marianas (MCM), a Guam non-profit corporation, to
6 permit this hospital to continue operations until a legislative
7 decision is reached regarding the purchase of the Medical Center
8 of the Marianas by the government of Guam.

9 Section 5. The Guam Economic Development Authority, through
10 its Board of Directors, shall execute a loan agreement with the
11 Medical Center of the Marianas for an amount not to exceed One
12 Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000). The Authority
13 shall require MCM to use the funds as a supplement to income
14 from operations for the purpose of paying salaries and other
15 operating expenses and prohibit use of the loan to pay debt
16 service or severance pay to the employees of MCM.

17 Section 6. The loan authorized by Sections 4 and 5 of
18 this Act shall be interest free and shall be repaid within ten
19 (10) years if the Medical Center of the Marianas is not purchased
20 by the government of Guam. If the government of Guam purchases
21 the Medical Center of the Marianas, then the loan balance shall
22 be paid by deducting the amount outstanding from the amount to
23 be paid by the government of Guam on the purchase price of MCM.
24 The funds deducted and any money received from MCM as repayment
25 of the loan shall be paid to Guam Economic Development Authority.
26 Guam Economic Development Authority shall pay to the government
27 of Guam for deposit in the General Fund any funds received as
28 repayment.

1 Section 7. Section 17111 of the Government Code is amended
2 to read:

3 "Section 17111. All land in the area known as Tumon
4 Bay as designated by the Bureau of Planning's Tamuning
5 Community Design Map No. 10, at the effective date of this
6 Act is zoned 'H' Resort-Hotel Zone pursuant to the
7 provisions of this Act."

8 Section 8. The Territorial Planning Commission shall adopt
9 within thirty (30) days following enactment of this Act such
10 interim regulations as required to enforce the intent and pro-
11 visions of the "H" Resort-Hotel Zone. Such interim regulations
12 shall be adopted pursuant to those procedures outlined in the
13 Administrative Adjudication Act, Title XXV of the Government
14 Code. Such interim regulations shall be in effect until adoption
15 of final regulations by the Territorial Planning Commission.
