




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPLEMENT
THE APPROPRIATIONS PREVIOUSLY MADE TO THE
GUAM CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from
3 the General Fund to the Guam Constitutional Convention for the
4 purposes expressly stated herein:

5 For Contractual Employment Services,
6 not to exceed \$20,160

7 For Printing and Publication of the
8 official proceedings, records and
9 documents of the Guam Constitutional
10 Convention, not to exceed \$14,000

11 For Office supplies and Materials,
12 not to exceed \$ 400

13 For a Public Education Program, limited
14 to printed educational matter and media
15 presentation provided by certified social
16 science educators, not to exceed \$14,000

17 (a) It is not the intent of this Section to alter or amend
18 in any way Section 15200.10 of the Government Code of Guam.

19 (b) The sum of Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000) is hereby
20 appropriated from any available balance of the General Fund to
21 the Election Commission for an education program for the non-
22 ratification of the proposed constitution. The sum herein

1 appropriated shall be available only for media advertising (radio,
2 television, newspaper, booklets and other handout materials).
3 Only non-profit organizations shall be entitled to any part or
4 portion of the appropriation herein above made as reimbursement
5 to such media advertisement. The Commission shall adopt rules
6 and regulations for the entitlement, allocation and expenditure
7 on the appropriations.

8 All available balances from the appropriation made herein
9 existing as of June 30, 1978 is hereby returned to the Unappro-
10 priated Surplus of the General Fund.


11 Section 2. Upon printing and publication of the official
12 history of the Guam Constitutional Convention, the Guam Legisla-
13 ture shall take custody of same and shall arrange in appropriate
14 manner for its distribution and release; provided, however, that
15 copies of same shall be released to the territorial archives
16 and government agencies without the benefit of sale. In no
17 instance shall the Guam Legislature release without charge
18 copies of the official history to private citizens or entities
19 and organizations outside of recognized governmental bodies.
20 In the event that the official history of the Convention contains
21 multiple volumes, the release or sale of it shall be by set.
22 Upon determination by the Legislature as to the number of sets
23 of the Convention's history available for sale, that number shall
24 be divided into the total cost of printing and rounded to the
25 next highest dollar value for determining the sale price. Pro-
26 ceeds from sales shall be deposited into the General Fund Account.

1 Section 3. All properties not disposed of or supplies and
2 materials not utilized by the Constitutional Convention as of
3 June 30, 1978 shall be transferred to Supply Management Division,
4 Department of Administration, government of Guam, for re-issue
5 to departments or agencies of government of Guam, as provided by
6 procurement and supply regulations.

7 Section 4. Section 15200.14 of the Government Code of
8 Guam is repealed and reenacted to read:

9 "Section 15200.14. Referendum. The proposed Consti-
10 tution as so approved or modified by the Congress shall
11 be submitted to the qualified voters of Guam for acceptance
12 or rejection through an islandwide referendum to be held
13 concurrently with the General Election held in 1978 as
14 provided in Section 2910 of the Government Code of Guam."

15 Section 5. Part 1, Section 1, IX.A.1.d., XV. and XVI. of
16 Public Law 14-43 are hereby amended to read:

19 1. Transportation Maintenance
