AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPLEMENT THE APPROPRIATIONS PREVIOUSLY MADE TO THE GUAM CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Guam Constitutional Convention for the purposes expressly stated herein:

For Contractual Employment Services,

not to exceed \$20,160

For Printing and Publication of the official proceedings, records and documents of the Guam Constitutional Convention, not to exceed \$14,000

For Office supplies and Materials, not to exceed \$400

For a Public Education Program, limited

(a) It is not the intent of this Section to alter or amend in any way Section 15200.10 of the Government Code of Guam.

to printed educational matter and media

science educators, not to exceed

presentation provided by certified social

(b) The sum of Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000) is hereby appropriated from any available balance of the General Fund to the Election Commission for an education program for the non-ratification of the proposed constitution. The sum herein

appropriated shall be available only for media advertising (radio, television, newspaper, booklets and other handout materials).

Only non-profit organizations shall be entitled to any part or portion of the appropriation herein above made as reimbursement to such media advertisement. The Commission shall adopt rules and regulations for the entitlement, allocation and expenditure on the appropriations.

All available balances from the appropriation made herein existing as of June 30, 1978 is hereby returned to the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund.

Section 2. Upon printing and publication of the official history of the Guam Constitutional Convention, the Guam Legislature shall take custody of same and shall arrange in appropriate manner for its distribution and release; provided, however, that copies of same shall be released to the territorial archives and government agencies without the benefit of sale. instance shall the Guam Legislature release without charge copies of the official history to private citizens or entities and organizations outside of recognized governmental bodies. In the event that the official history of the Convention contains multiple volumes, the release or sale of it shall be by set. Upon determination by the Legislature as to the number of sets of the Convention's history available for sale, that number shall be divided into the total cost of printing and rounded to the next highest dollar value for determining the sale price. ceeds from sales shall be deposited into the General Fund Account.
