


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 12311 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE TO PROHIBIT CERTAIN NET FISHING WITHIN
THE AGANA BOAT BASIN PROPER.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 12311 of the Government Code is amended
3 to read:

4 "Section 12311. Taking of fish. Fish may be taken by
5 lawful means at any time except as prohibited by regulation
6 made under Section 12321, provided, however, that it shall be
7 unlawful for any person to place or maintain a drag net,
8 (Chenchulu or tecken) within Agana Boat Basin proper; and
9 further provided that angling and cast-net (talaya) fishing
10 are the only approved methods of fishing within the Agana
11 Boat Basin proper and within fifty (50) feet of the western
12 edge of the Agana Boat Basin channel on conditions as
13 follows:

14 (a) When angling, not more than three hooks shall
15 be attached to the mainline and no snagging methods
16 shall be used.

17 (b) The use of the cast-net (talaya) is prohibited
18 within the Agana Boat Basin proper. Within the
19 channel, it may be used during the hours of 3:00 a.m.
20 and 7:00 a.m. However, the cast-net (Talaya) is not
21 permitted to be thrown within the channel (or Basin
22 proper) from any boat, whether stationary or in motion.

23 (c) The use of the cast-net (talaya) is pro-
24 hibited if there is any rope attached to the net.
