AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE OPERATION OF THE FOURTEENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE FOR CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1978, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
