AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PAINTING OF PORTRAITS OF FORMER GOVERNORS MANUEL F. LEON GUERRERO AND CARLOS G. CAMACHO AND GOVERNOR RICARDO J. BORDALLO AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500) is appropriated from any available balance of the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the painting of portraits of former Governors Manuel F. Leon Guerrero, Carlos G. Camacho and incumbent Governor Ricardo J. Bordallo.

Section 2. A new Section 175 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 175. Each Governor shall have his portrait painted during his term of office for display in a government of Guam facility. The portrait is the property of the people of Guam."

Section 3. Should there be a balance on the funds appropriated in Section 1, such balance should be spent on the painting of portraits of retiring members of the Fourteenth Guam Legislature.
