

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE
PAINTING OF PORTRAITS OF FORMER GOVERNORS
MANUEL F. LEON GUERRERO AND CARLOS G.
CAMACHO AND GOVERNOR RICARDO J. BORDALLO
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars
3 (\$7,500) is appropriated from any available balance of the
4 Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the painting
5 of portraits of former Governors Manuel F. Leon Guerrero, Carlos
6 G. Camacho and incumbent Governor Ricardo J. Bordallo.

7 Section 2. A new Section 175 is added to the Government
8 Code to read:

9 "Section 175. Each Governor shall have his portrait
10 painted during his term of office for display in a govern-
11 ment of Guam facility. The portrait is the property of
12 the people of Guam."

13 Section 3. Should there be a balance on the funds appro-
14 priated in Section 1, such balance should be spent on the painting
15 of portraits of retiring members of the Fourteenth Guam Legisla-
16 ture.
