AN ACT TO ASSEND SECTION 6982 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO EXTEND THE APPLICATION DEADLINE FOR VETERARS BONUSES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Section 1. Section 8982 of the Government Code is amended to read:

"Section 8582. Application for bonuses. All applications for benuses authorized by this Chapter must be made to the Office of Veteran's Affairs on or before December 31, 1978. Each applicant shall furnish to the Office of Veteran's Affairs evidence of his eligibility for a veteran's bonus. Eligibility may be evidenced by authorizated copies of records or certificates issued by the Department of Defense, U. S. Hilitary Service Department or any other authorized agency having such evidence in its possession. Records or certificates shall show:

(1) World War II applicants. Proof of active service during the period beginning December 7, 1941 and ending December 31, 1946.

(2) Korean Conflict applicants. Proof of the award of the Korean Service Medal.

(3) Indo-China Conflict applicants. Proof of the award of the Vietnam Service Medal." Section 2. Section 1 of Public Law 13-180 is amended to read:

"Section 1. There is appropriated from any tax revenue received by the government of Guam pursuant to Section 59010, as amended, of the Government Code the sum of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) to pay to eligible veterans, Guam Combat Patrol members and Civilian Scouts the bonuses authorized by Sections 8981, 8985 and 8990 of the Government Code and transferred to a special account in the General Fund, said sum to be allocated and used for the purpose of paying to eligible persons the bonuses authorized by Chapters XIV-A, XIV-B and XV, Title IX of the Government Code." Section 3. Sections 8987 and 8994 of the Government Code

are repealed.

Section 4. Subsection (b) of Section 8991 of the Government Code is amended to read:

"All applications for the bonuses authorized by this Chapter must be made to the Director of Public Safety on or before December 31, 1978."
