AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 8982 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE TO EXTEND THE APPLICATION DEADLINE FOR
VETERANS BONUSES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 8982 of the Government Code is amended

to read:

"Section 8982. Application for bonuses. All applica-
tions for bonuses authorized by this Chapter must be made
to the Office of Veteran's Affairs on or before December
31, 1978. Each applicant shall furnish to the Office of
Veteran's Affairs evidence of his eligibility for a veteran's
bonus. Eligibility may be evidenced by authenticated
copies of records or certificates issued by the Department
of Defense, U. S. Military Service Department or any
other authorized agency having such evidence in its posses-
sion. Records or certificates shall show:

(1) World War II applicants. Proof of active
service during the period beginning December 7, 1941
and ending December 31, 1946.

1 (2) Korean Conflict applicants. Proof of the
2 award of the Korean Service Medal.

3 (3) Indo-China Conflict applicants. Proof
4 of the award of the Vietnam Service Medal."

5 Section 2. Section 1 of Public Law 13-180 is amended to
6 read:

7 "Section 1. There is appropriated from any tax revenue
8 received by the government of Guam pursuant to Section 59010,
9 as amended, of the Government Code the sum of Three Million
10 Dollars (\$3,000,000) to pay to eligible veterans, Guam
11 Combat Patrol members and Civilian Scouts the bonuses
12 authorized by Sections 8981, 8985 and 8990 of the Government
13 Code and transferred to a special account in the General
14 Fund, said sum to be allocated and used for the purpose of
15 paying to eligible persons the bonuses authorized by Chapters
16 XIV-A, XIV-B and XV, Title IX of the Government Code."

17 Section 3. Sections 8987 and 8994 of the Government Code
18 are repealed.

19 Section 4. Subsection (b) of Section 8991 of the Government
20 Code is amended to read:

21 "All applications for the bonuses authorized by this
22 Chapter must be made to the Director of Public Safety on
23 or before December 31, 1978."
