




AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR IMPROVEMENT  
OF P. C. SANTOS MEMORIAL PARK IN PITI AND  
AFLEJE BEACH PARK IN AGAT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
3 balance in the Tourist Attraction Fund the sum of Eighty-Nine  
4 Thousand Dollars (\$89,000) for construction of chamorro huts  
5 or a reasonable facsimile thereof and picnic facilities, and  
6 improvement of the parking area, for the construction of a  
7 pedestrian wooden bridge and restroom facilities and for general  
8 improvement of the P. C. Santos Memorial Park in the municipality  
9 of Piti.

10 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
11 balance in the Tourist Attraction Fund the sum of Eighty-Five  
12 Thousand Dollars (\$85,000) for repair of the pavillion and con-  
13 struction of new restroom facilities at the Afleje Beach Park

1 to provide the basic facilities needed for the relaxation and  
2 enjoyment of the local people, military personnel and off-island  
3 visitors.

4 Section 3. The appropriations made by Sections 1 and 2 of  
5 this Act shall be administered by the Department of Parks and  
6 Recreation in coordination with the Guam Visitors Bureau.

7 Section 4. Section 3, including Subsection a, of Public  
8 Law 14-53 is amended to read:

9 "Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any  
10 available balance of the Territorial Highway Fund the  
11 sum of Five Million Twelve Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Seven  
12 Dollars (\$5,012,537) including Three Million Four Hundred  
13 Two Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Seven Dollars (\$3,402,677)  
14 in FHWA funds for the following projects:

15 a. Route 14 reconstruction from  
16 Route 1 to Guam Memorial  
17 Hospital \$1,725,000"

18 Section 5. Section 16 of Public Law 12-114 is repealed and  
19 reenacted to read:

20 "Section 16. There is hereby appropriated from the  
21 General Fund to PUAG the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand  
22 Dollars (\$25,000) for the purpose of rectifying the sewer  
23 connection problem along Gutierrez Drive in Agana Heights."

24 Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from the General  
25 Fund the sum of Four Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars  
26 (\$475,000), to implement the provisions of Section 15012 of the  
27 Government Code.

28 Section 7. The money appropriated in Section 6 of this Act  
29 shall be used in calendar year 1973, beginning January 1, of  
30 said year, provided, however, that a Municipal Planning Council  
31 has been created pursuant to Section 15020 of Chapter 1, Title  
32 XVI of the Government Code of Guam.
