



AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR OVERTIME
OBLIGATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
SAFETY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated
3 from any available funds such sums as are necessary to compensate
4 uniformed personnel of the Department of Public Safety for over-
5 time services rendered during fiscal year 1976. Not later than
6 thirty (30) days after the enactment of this Act, the Director
7 of Public Safety shall transmit to the Legislature written state-
8 ments giving reason(s) for earlier denial of payment by the
9 department to its employees and indicating whether the claims now
10 filed are valid and proper to be paid.

11 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Department
12 of Public Safety the sum of Ninety-Three Thousand One Hundred
13 Eighty-Nine Dollars (\$93,189) from any available balance of the
14 General Fund for payment of outstanding overtime obligations to
15 uniformed personnel of the Department of Public Safety for fiscal
16 year 1977.

17 Section 3. Part I, Section 1, II., B.3.a. and b. of Public
18 Law 14-45, as amended, is further amended to read:

19 "II. Public Safety

20 B. Department of Public Safety

21 3. Police Operations Bureau

22 a. Personal Services \$3,151,000
23 b. Personnel Benefits 368,640."

1 Section 4. The sum of One Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand One
2 Hundred Eighty-Nine Dollars (\$152,189) is hereby transferred from
3 the Personal Services Lapse Fund to the Unappropriated Surplus of
4 the General Fund to partially satisfy the appropriations made by
5 Sections 2 and 3 of this Act.

6 Section 5. The appropriation made by Sections 2 and 3 of
7 this Act shall not be expended until such time as the Department
8 of Public Safety shall have developed and implemented policies,
9 rules or regulations governing overtime services, which shall
10 include, among others, the following:

- 11 A. No overtime compensation shall be authorized if
12 funds are not available, except under emergency
13 conditions involving the safety of human lives;
- 14 B. Should such emergency conditions exist, the
15 Department of Public Safety shall, no less
16 than thirty (30) days after the overtime
17 service is rendered, transmit to the Legislature
18 a request for funds to pay for the overtime
19 obligation.
