AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR OVERTIME OBLICATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated from any available funds such sums as are necessary to compensate uniformed personnel of the Department of Public Safety for overtime services rendered during fiscal year 1976. Not later than thirty (30) days after the enactment of this Act, the Director of Public Safety shall transmit to the Legislature written statements giving reason(s) for earlier denial of payment by the department to its employees and indicating whether the claims now filed are valid and proper to be paid.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Public Safety the sum of Minety-Three Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Nine Bollars (\$93,189) from any available balance of the General Fund for payment of outstanding overtime obligations to uniformed personnel of the Department of Public Safety for fiscal year 1977.

Section 3. Part I, Section 1, II., B.3.a. and b. of Public Law 14-43, as amended, is further amended to read:

"II. Public Safety

- B. Department of Public Safety
 - 3. Police Operations Bureau
 - a. Forsonal Services

Section 4. The sum of One Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Nine Bollars (\$152,189) is hereby transferred from the Personal Services Lapse Fund to the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to partially satisfy the appropriations made by Sections Z and 3 of this Act.

Section 5. The appropriation made by Sections 2 and 3 of this Act shall not be expended until such time as the Department of Public Safety shall have developed and implemented policies, rules or regulations governing overtime services, which shall include, among others, the following:

- A. No overtime compensation shall be authorized if funds are not available, except under emergency conditions involving the safety of human lives;
- B. Should such emergency conditions exist, the Department of Public Safety shall, no less than thirty (30) days after the overtime service is rendered, transmit to the Legislature a request for funds to pay for the overtime obligation.
