AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS, THE UMATAC-MERIZO SEWER SYSTEM, THE REHABILITATION AND IMPROVEMENT OF VARIOUS PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance of the General Fund the sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) for contribution to the Territorial Highway Fund as local matching funds for capital improvement projects.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance of the Territorial Highway Fund the sum of Nine Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$9,500,000) in FHWA grants for the construction of highway capital improvement projects within the limits specified herein:

Section 3. The projects identified in Section 2 of this Act shall be scheduled for construction in a manner that best utilizes the availability of FHWA grants.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance of the General Fund the sum of Five Million Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Two Hundred and Twenty Dollars (\$5,950,220) consisting of Four Million Three Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,332,500) of Federal EPA Funds, One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) from the Rehabilitation Funds as reprogrammed by Resolution No. 74 passed by the Fourteenth Guam Legislature on May 6, 1977 and Six Hundred Seventeen Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$617,720) from any available balance of the General Fund for the construction of the Umatac-Merizo Sewer System.

Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance of the General Fund the sum of One Million One Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$1,122,400) consisting of Nine Hundred Sixty-Two Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$962,400) in federal grants from the United States Department of Health, Education and Welfare and One Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$160,000) from any available balance of the General Fund for the restoration and updating of the Agat Junior High School in conformance with the Uniform Building Code.

Untalan) Junior High School and the following elementary schools:

Section 8. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance of the General Fund the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$759,000) consisting of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) in HEW grants and Six Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$659,000) local matching to the University of Guam Fund to be used for the construction of the University of Guam Robert F. Kennedy Library expansion project.

Section 9. The special appropriation made by the United States Congress to reimburse the territory of Guam for losses in revenue as authorized by Section 402 of the Omnibus Territories Act (P. L. 95-134) is hereby identified as the primary source of funding for the appropriations made under this Act.
