

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE  
CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS, THE UMATAC-MERIZO  
SEWER SYSTEM, THE REHABILITATION AND  
IMPROVEMENT OF VARIOUS PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND  
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
balance of the General Fund the sum of One Million Dollars  
(\$1,000,000) for contribution to the Territorial Highway Fund  
as local matching funds for capital improvement projects.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
balance of the Territorial Highway Fund the sum of Nine Million  
Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$9,500,000) in FHWA grants for  
the construction of highway capital improvement projects within  
the limits specified herein:

9 Section 3. The projects identified in Section 2 of this Act  
10 shall be scheduled for construction in a manner that best utilizes  
11 the availability of FHWA grants.

12 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
13 balance of the General Fund the sum of Five Million Nine Hundred  
14 Fifty Thousand Two Hundred and Twenty Dollars (\$5,950,220) con-  
15 sisting of Four Million Three Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Five  
16 Hundred Dollars (\$4,332,500) of Federal EPA Funds, One Million  
17 Dollars (\$1,000,000) from the Rehabilitation Funds as reprogrammed  
18 by Resolution No. 74 passed by the Fourteenth Guam Legislature on  
19 May 6, 1977 and Six Hundred Seventeen Thousand Seven Hundred  
20 Twenty Dollars (\$617,720) from any available balance of the  
21 General Fund for the construction of the Umatac-Merizo Sewer  
22 System.

23 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
24 balance of the General Fund the sum of One Million One Hundred  
25 Twenty-Two Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$1,122,400) consisting  
26 of Nine Hundred Sixty-Two Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$962,400)  
27 in federal grants from the United States Department of Health,  
28 Education and Welfare and One Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars  
29 (\$160,000) from any available balance of the General Fund for  
30 the restoration and updating of the Agat Junior High School in  
31 conformance with the Uniform Building Code.

Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand Four Hundred Seventy-Four Dollars (\$157,474) consisting of a grant from the United States Department of Health, Education and Welfare for the procurement of collateral equipment for the Agat Junior High School.

Section 7. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance of the General Fund the sum of One Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,800,000) for the design and rehabilitation of the Simon Sanchez Jr. High School and Agana Heights Elementary School and the renovation and improvement of Barrigada (Luis P. Untalan) Junior High School and the following elementary schools: B. P. Carbullido, C. L. Taitano, P. C. Lujan, Tamuning, Adelup, J. B. Torres, Old Piti, New Piti, Wettengel Elementary and any other school which the Director of Education determines to be in need of emergency repair.

Section 8. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance of the General Fund the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$759,000) consisting of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) in HEW grants and Six Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$659,000) local matching to the University of Guam Fund to be used for the construction of the University of Guam Robert F. Kennedy Library expansion project.

Section 9. The special appropriation made by the United States Congress to reimburse the territory of Guam for losses in revenue as authorized by Section 402 of the Omnibus Territories Act (P. L. 95-134) is hereby identified as the primary source of funding for the appropriations made under this Act.

1 Section 10. Part I, Section 1.IV.C.6.a. b. and d. of Public  
2 Law 14-43 are amended to read as follows:
