




AN ACT MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION  
TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL  
SERVICES FOR PUBLIC ASSISTANCE FUNDS FOR  
FISCAL YEAR 1978, PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1978  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

8 Section 7. A new item 17 is added to paragraph (c) of item 3  
9 of Subsection b. of Section 27202 of the Government Code to read:

10 "17. Establish, and from time to time, revise the fee  
11 schedule necessary to carry into effect the provisions of  
12 this Chapter."

13 Section 8. Subsection c. of Section 27203 of the Government

25 "Section 27205. Renewal of license. 1. The license  
26 of every person licensed under the provisions of this Act  
27 shall expire on the thirtieth (30th) day of June and shall be  
28 renewed annually. Each licensee shall be notified at least  
29 two (2) months in advance of expiration date by the Board.  
30 The Board shall mail an application for yearly renewal during

1 the current year. The applicant shall submit the application  
2 and return it to the Board with the renewal fee before June  
3 30. Upon receipt of the application and fee, the Board  
4 shall verify the accuracy of the application and issue to  
5 the applicant a certificate of renewal for the current year  
6 beginning July 1 and expiring June 30. Such renewal shall  
7 render the holder thereof a legal practitioner of nursing  
8 for the period stated on the renewal form.

9 2. A nurse who does not engage in nursing in Guam  
10 during the succeeding year shall not be required to pay the  
11 renewal fee as long as he or she remains inactive. Should  
12 he or she wish to resume nursing at some future time he  
13 or she shall so notify the Board and remit the reinstatement  
14 fee."
