the current year. The applicant shall submit the application and return it to the Board with the renewal fee before June 30. Upon receipt of the application and fee, the Board shall verify the accuracy of the application and issue to the applicant a certificate of renewal for the current year beginning July 1 and expiring June 30. Such renewal shall render the holder thereof a legal practitioner of nursing for the period stated on the renewal form.

2. A nurse who does not engage in nursing in Guam during the succeeding year shall not be required to pay the renewal fee as long as he or she remains inactive. Should he or she wish to resume nursing at some future time he or she shall so notify the Board and remit the reinstatement fee."
