AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A BUDGET FOR THE OFFICE OF SURUHANU.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the General

Fund for the operation of the Office of the Suruhanu for the calendar year ending December 31, 1978 the sum of Seventy-One Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Three Dollars (\$71,443) to be

allocated as follows:

For Personnel Costs, not to exceed \$47,443
For Non-Personnel Costs, not to exceed \$24,000

Section 2. The sum appropriated herein shall be transferred to the Legislature Operations Fund.

Section 3. The Guam Legislature's Committee on Rules is hereby directed to immediately initiate and to recommend to the Legislature the appointment of the Suruhanu.
