

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A BUDGET FOR THE
OFFICE OF SURUHANU.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the General
3 Fund for the operation of the Office of the Suruhanu for the
4 calendar year ending December 31, 1978 the sum of Seventy-One
5 Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Three Dollars (\$71,443) to be
6 allocated as follows:

7 For Personnel Costs, not to exceed \$47,443

8 For Non-Personnel Costs, not to exceed \$24,000

9 Section 2. The sum appropriated herein shall be transferred
10 to the Legislature Operations Fund.

11 Section 3. The Guam Legislature's Committee on Rules is
12 hereby directed to immediately initiate and to recommend to
13 the Legislature the appointment of the Suruhanu.
