

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE TWO MILLION  
DOLLARS (\$2,000,000) FROM THE TERRITORY  
HIGHWAY FUND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A  
NEW TALOFOFO BRIDGE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM;

2 Legislative Findings. The Legislature finds that Route 4  
3 is an integral link of the southern area of Guam and the safety  
4 and well-being of the citizens of Guam require that Route 4  
5 be properly maintained allowing freedom of movement. The  
6 present bridge on Route 4 across the Talofofu River is unsafe  
7 and must be replaced as soon as possible.

8 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any balance  
9 in the Territorial Highway Fund the sum of Two Million Dollars  
10 (\$2,000,000) for the purpose of constructing a new bridge on  
11 Route 4 across the Talofofu River. The above appropriation  
12 shall include One Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars  
13 (\$1,400,000) in Federal Grants from the Federal Highway Act and  
14 Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000) in local matching.  
15 Any unexpended balance of this appropriation remaining after  
16 December 31, 1979 shall revert to the Territorial Highway Fund.

17 Section 2. Section 3, Subsection j of Public Law 14-33 is  
18 amended to read:

19 "j. Talofofu Bridge Design \$45,000"

1           Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
2 balance of the General Fund the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars  
3 (\$10,000) to the Department of Education for relocation of  
4 temporary classrooms to Agana Heights and Ulloa Elementary  
5 Schools.

6           Section 4. The sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) is  
7 hereby transferred from the Personnel Services Lapse Fund to  
8 the General Fund to satisfy the appropriation made by Section 3  
9 of this Act.

10          Section 5. Subsection (a) of Section 7 of Public Law 14-87  
11 is amended to read:

12           "a. Except those whose salaries are established by  
13 statute, all positions in the Guam Economic Development  
14 Authority, Guam Election Commission, Government House,  
15 Public Defender Corporation, Guam Visitors Bureau, Univer-  
16 sity of Guam, Public Utility Agency of Guam, Guam Telephone  
17 Authority, Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority, Guam  
18 Memorial Hospital Authority, Port Authority of Guam, Guam  
19 Housing Corporation, Guam Airport Authority, Guam Power  
20 Authority, Judicial Branch and the Legislative Branch  
21 shall receive salary increases as follows:

22                   On January 1, 1978 an increase of \$700 per  
23 annum and on July 1, 1978, an increase of \$700 per  
24 annum."

25          Section 6. The appropriations made within Part 1, Section  
26 One, Subsections V., A., a. and b. of Public Law 14-43 is  
27 amended to read:

28           "A. Commissioners of Guam

29           a. Personal Services	\$485,768
30           b. Personnel Benefits	\$ 54,298."
