


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS  
FOR THE OPERATION OF GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL  
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1978  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Part I, Section 1. III.B.1. of Public Law 14-43

is hereby amended to read:  
"III. For Public Health

B. Guam Memorial Hospital Authority  
1. Contribution to Hospital  
(\$4,351,699) to the Operations Fund

Section 2. Part II, Section 3.A.1. of Public Law 14-43

is hereby amended to read:

"Section 3.A. There is hereby appropriated from any  
available balance in the Hospital Operation Fund the  
following sums consisting of Four Million Three Hundred  
Fifty-One Thousand Six Hundred Ninety-Nine Dollars  
(\$4,551,699) contribution from the General Fund, Four Million  
Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,500,000) from fees for  
service and Five Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Two Hundred  
Ninety-Six Dollars (\$548,296) for FGIA for the fiscal year  
ending June 30, 1978.

2. Custodial Care Facility

1 (a) 3. Mental Health Services

5 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
6 balance of the General Fund the sum of Three Hundred Seventy-Nine  
7 Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$379,200) to the Department of  
8 Public Works for the purchase of 12 new 60-passenger school buses  
9 to replace deadlined units.

10 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
11 balance in the General Fund the sum of Twelve Thousand Three  
12 Hundred Dollars (\$12,300) to the Guam Power Authority for exten-  
13 sion of power lines to Mataguac, Yigo.

14 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
15 balance of the General Fund the sum of Seventy Thousand Dollars  
16 (\$70,000) to the Department of Education for maintenance and  
17 repair of air conditioning units at M. U. Lujan, Finegayan and  
18 Anderson Elementary School.

19 Section 6. The sum of Seventy-Six Thousand Six Hundred  
20 Ninety Dollars (\$76,690) is appropriated from the Tourist Attrac-  
21 tion Fund to the University of Guam's Marine Laboratory for the  
22 purpose of removing holoturians (sea cucumbers) and studying the  
23 environmental impact their removal will have, subject to the  
24 conditions established herein:

25 (a) Removal of the holoturians (sea cucumbers) and the  
26 accompanying scientific study of the environmental impact  
27 of their removal shall be restricted to Tumon Bay between  
28 Ipaog Beach and Gun Beach;

29 (b) All phases of the project shall be suspended if in  
30 the opinion of its directors, removal of holoturians is  
31 determined to be environmentally unsound;

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(c) For the purpose of initiating and completing this project, the employment of persons shall be temporary and exempt from the personnel rules and regulations of the government of Guam;

(d) Interim reports concerning the project's progress shall be submitted to the Legislature beginning August 31, 1978 and quarterly thereafter;

(e) No expenditures from this appropriation shall be made subsequent to August 31, 1979 at which time, unexpended funds shall be returned to the Unappropriated Surplus of the Tourist Attraction Fund; and

(f) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, rule or regulation to the contrary, nothing shall preclude the sale of holoturians (sea cucumbers) or any by-products by the University of Guam Marine Laboratory with the proceeds of such sales to be deposited in the Tourist Attraction Fund.

Section 7. Part I, Sections I.C.a. and b. of Public Law 14-43 are amended to read as follows:

17 Section 10. The sum of Twenty-Seven Thousand Seven Hundred  
18 Seventeen Dollars (\$27,717) is hereby appropriated from the  
19 "Personal Services Lapse Fund" created by Part III, Section J of  
20 Public Law 14-43 to satisfy the appropriations made by Sections  
21 7 through 9 of this Act.
