

Introduced by B. M. Palomo

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4005 OF THE GOVERNMENT  
CODE RELATIVE TO COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS OF  
CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4005 of the Government Code is amended  
3 to read:

4 "Section 4005. Civil Service Commission. There is  
5 hereby established, in and for the government of Guam, a  
6 Civil Service Commission, composed of seven (7) members,  
7 appointed by the Governor with the consent of the Legislature.  
8 Members shall serve for a term of three (3) years, provided  
9 that of the initial members appointed, one (1) shall serve  
10 for one (1) year, three (3) for two (2) years and three (3)  
11 for three (3) years. No member shall be either an employee  
12 of the government of Guam or a member of any other board or  
13 commission thereof. The Commission is authorized to employ  
14 its own staff. Each member of the Commission shall receive  
15 the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each attendance at  
16 the meetings of the Commission, provided, however that no  
17 member shall receive more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)  
18 per month."

19 Section 2. Section 4220 of the Government Code is amended  
20 to read:

21 "Section 4220. Board of Trustees. The responsibility  
22 for the proper operation of the fund and the direction of  
23 its policies shall be vested in a Board of Trustees of five

1 (5) members, consisting of the Director of the Department of  
2 Administration, ex-officio, two (2) members appointed by  
3 the Governor who shall be employees having at least five (5)  
4 years of service and participants in the fund, and two (2)  
5 members appointed by the Governor who shall not be employees  
6 of the government. The term of office of the appointive  
7 members shall be for five (5) years, except that the original  
8 appointees shall be appointed for terms of one (1), two (2),  
9 three (3), and four (4) years. As their terms expire, new  
10 members shall be appointed to fill vacancies and such appoint-  
11 ment shall be made for terms of five (5) years. Each member  
12 of the Board of Trustees shall receive the sum of Fifty  
13 Dollars (\$50.00) for each attendance at the meetings of the  
14 Board, provided, however, that no member shall receive more  
15 than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per month; provided,  
16 further that no board member who is an employee of the govern-  
17 ment of Guam shall receive compensation if the meeting  
18 attended is held during regular working hours."

19 Section 3. Section 42010 of the Government Code of Guam  
20 is hereby repealed and reenacted to read:

21 "Section 42010. Same: Compensation: Members of the  
22 Board shall receive the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for  
23 each attendance at the meetings of the Board, provided, how-  
24 ever, that no member shall receive more than One Hundred  
25 Dollars (\$100.00) per month."

26 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from the General  
27 Fund the following sums:

28 A. The sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) to the  
29 Chamorro Language Commission to defray all expenses in  
30 conducting a seminar-workshop on the Chamorro Language.

1           B. The sum of Two Hundred Forty-Two Thousand Dollars  
2           (\$242,000) for the construction of three (3) dry wells/ponding  
3           basins in Agana Heights for flood control purposes. Said  
44          sum is to augment an earlier appropriation made in Public  
5           Law 13-201.

6           Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from the General  
7           Fund the sum of Ten Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$10,500) for  
8           the operation of Youth Week 1978. No amount of this appropriation  
9           shall be expended until the report that is due on or before June  
10          1, 1977 is received by the Legislature.

11          Section A. Governor's staff responsible for the Youth  
12          Bureau shall have purview over the disbursement of funds,  
13          maintaining of records, administering revenues, providing  
14          manpower as needed, insuring the compliance of the report  
15          due date, and other logistical support as needed.

16          Section B. The certifying officer shall be the Director  
17          of the Bureau of Budget and Management Research or his  
18          designee.

19          Section C. Any nonexpended items purchased with funds  
20          under Section 5 of this Act shall be stored for use in the  
21          ensuing Youth Week.

22          Section D. All proceeds collected from activities  
23          during Youth Week 1978 may be expended for the operation of  
24          Youth Week 1978.

25          Section E. The Central Planning Committee will submit  
26          to the Legislature, the Youth Congress and the Governor of  
27          Guam a full report of the Youth Week activities, including  
28          an analysis of all income and expenditures, on or before  
29          June 1, 1978.

30          Section F. Sections 5 A thru E of this Act shall be  
31          effective immediately.

1           Section 6. The sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) is  
2 appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund  
3 for the drainage improvements at the Guzman Memorial Baseball  
4 Field in the municipality of Santa Rita.

5           Section 7. The sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) is  
6 hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Public Utility  
7 Agency of Guam for the installation of waterlines and related  
8 appurtenances necessary to provide water for the irrigation of  
9 those areas used as farms located in the eighty acre lots leased  
10 from the Navy which lots are situated opposite P. C. Lujan Elemen-  
11 tary School in Radio Barrigada along Route 8.
