


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO ADD SUBSECTION (p) TO SECTION
4203 AND TO AMEND SECTION 4234(a) OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Subsection (p) is added to Section 4203 of
3 the Government Code to read:

4 "(p) 'Uniformed personnel' means police officers and
5 firemen in the Department of Public Safety, Customs and
6 Quarantine Officers in the Department of Commerce, Conserva-
7 tion Officers of the Department of Agriculture and Correction
8 Officers of the Department of Corrections."

9 Section 2. Section 47136 of the Government Code is amended
10 to read:

11 "Section 47136. Charges for services of customs and
12 quarantine officers. All air and sea carriers and other
13 persons whose operations require the services of Customs

1 and Quarantine Officers of the government of Guam shall be
2 charged for said services as are rendered by such officers
3 on any day of the week upon special request, Sunday, holi-
4 days, or between the hours of 5 P.M. of any day and 8 A.M.
5 of the following day as follows: for the first hour or frac-
6 tion thereof of such services, the hourly wage rate of
7 three (3) hours of service by whichever officer is performing
8 such service, plus twenty-five percent (25%) thereof for
9 administrative overhead and overtime. In addition to the
10 first-hour charge for any hour or fraction thereof over one
11 (1) hour, one and one-half (1.5) times three (3) hours, the
12 hourly wage rate of whichever officer performs such services,
13 plus twenty-five percent (25%) thereof for administrative
14 overhead. Any sum received by the government of Guam for
15 such overtime work shall be reimbursed to the employee who
16 who has rendered such service, regardless of his pay range,
17 less the twenty-five percent (25%) administrative overhead
18 which shall be used for the government contribution to the
19 Retirement Fund and the balance thereof shall be deposited
20 to the Customs and Quarantine Overtime Revolving Fund.
21 Non-performance of services. If services which have been
22 requested and the officer has reported to work and the
23 services are not performed by reason of circumstances beyond
24 the control of the officers concerned, the interested party
25 shall be charged on the same basis as though the services
26 had actually been performed during the period between the
27 time the officer was ordered to report for duty and did so
28 report and the times he was notified that his services would
29 not be required, a minimum charge of two (2) hours of his
30 hourly rate plus twenty-five percent (25%) thereof for
31 administrative overhead and overtime.

1 Assignment. The Chief of Customs and Quarantine Division is
2 authorized to order an officer to report for any overtime duty
3 15 minutes in advance of the scheduled time to avoid un-
4 necessary delay."

5 Section 3. Section 4234(a) of the Government Code of Guam
6 is amended to read:

7 "(a) Any person who is elected Governor or Lieutenant
8 Governor may retire following the completion of his term of
9 office as the Governor or Lieutenant Governor of the terri-
10 tory of Guam. He shall be paid from the Retirement Fund
11 by appropriation made by the Legislature notwithstanding the
12 amount of his contributions thereto an annual pension during
13 the remainder of his life in an amount equal to and not to
14 exceed fifty percent (50%) of the annual salary of the
15 Governor or Lieutenant Governor at the time he retires."
