

AN ACT TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW 14-43 FOR
THE PURPOSE OF SUPPLEMENTING THE OPERA-
TIONAL BUDGET OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRI-
CULTURE FOR FISCAL YEAR 1978 AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Items c and d are amended and a new item e is
3 added to Part One, Section I.VII.B.1 of Public Law 14-43 to
4 read:

24 Abuse Agency for the establishment and implementation of the drug
25 abuse program, "Operation Save-a-Life", for the remainder of
26 fiscal year 1978.

16 Fund the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) for the
17 initial operation of the Guam Amateur Boxing Program as established
18 by Public Law 14-13.

19 Section 13. Section 2 of Public Law 13-27 is hereby amended
20 to read as follows:

21 "Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the
22 Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One
23 Hundred Forty-Six Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars
24 and Sixty-Four Cents (\$146,284.64) to supplement the appro-
25 priation made under Section 10 of Public Law 12-198, said

24 authorized to borrow Five Million Four Hundred Forty-Nine Thousand
25 Dollars (\$5,449,000) to complete reconstruction and rehabilitation
26 of the telephone system on Guam.
