#### Introduced by Committee on Rules at the request of the Governor

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE OPERATIONS OF THE EXECUTIVE AND JUDI-CIAL BRANCHES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1979 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

#### PART ONE

Section 2. Any increase in the amounts of real estate taxes on land shown in 1977 Real Estate Tax Roll as a result of the recent triennal evaluation shall be made effective in the following manner:

33 1/3 percent of the increase shall become effective for the tax year 1978;

66 2/3 percent of the increase shall become effective for the tax year 1979; and

100 percent of the increase shall become effective for the tax year 1980.

#### PART TWO

#### OPERATIONS BUDGET

Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the operations of the Executive Branch of the government of Guam for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 1979. The sums appropriated shall be expended as specified in the following subsections of this section subject to the conditions further set forth in the other parts of this Act. It shall be unlawful to make any expenditures from the sums appropriated hereunder unless such expenditures are in accordance with the conditions set forth in this Act.

Section 9. The appropriations made by Sections 6, 7, and 8 of Part Five of this Act shall be effective October 1, 1978 through September 30, 1979.

Section 10. The administration of funds appropriated by Sections 6, 7, and 8 of Part Five of this Act shall be governed by all applicable provisions of Public Law 14-83.

Section 11. The sum of One Million Nine Hundred Fifty-Three Thousand Dollars (\$1,955,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the autonomous agencies to implement the provisions of Subsection (a) of Section 7 of Public Law 14-87, as amended by Public Law 14-117.

Section 12. The sum of One Million Nine Hundred Twenty
Thousand Dollars (\$1,920,000) is appropriated from the General
Fund to the Retirement Fund to implement the provisions of
Section 11 of Public Law 14-87.

(a). The Director of Administration is hereby directed to transfer said sum from the General Fund to the Retirement Fund on July 1, 1978.

Section 13. A new Section 5151.1 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 5151.1. Fiscal Year. The fiscal year of the government of Guam shall be October 1st through September 30th."

Section 14. Transition. Implementation of Section 13 of this Part shall take effect on October 1, 1978. The Governor on or before March 1, 1979 shall submit a supplemental budget for the period of July 1, 1979 through September 30, 1979. Commencing with Fiscal Year 1979-80, the Governor's budget shall be for the twelve-month Fiscal Year.

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Section 15. The sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Off-Island Sports Travel Fund, created by Public Law 14-35, to be administered by the Department of Parks & Recreation for Fiscal Year 1979.

Section 16. Section 1, IV, A of Public Law 14-87 is amended to read:

"IV. General Operation of the Fourteenth Guam Legislature.

A. For expenses of General Operations, to include Personal Services, Personnel Benefits, Travel and Transportation, Contractual Services, Supplies and Materials, Equipment, Miscellaneous and Contingent Expenses, not to exceed \$1,294,822.00".

Section 17. The Department of Law budget, as enacted by Public Law 14-43, is hereby amended as follows:

"Personnel lapsed funds may be used to pay \$1,136.13 in overtime incurred by Department of Law clerical personnel from July 1977 through December 31, 1977."

Section 18. Section 121 of the Code of Civil Procedure is repealed and reenacted to read:

"Section 121. Composition. There shall be a Judicial Council of Guam, which shall consist of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court who shall be chairman, the Chairman

of the Committee on Judiciary and Criminal Justice of the Legislature, the Attorney General of Guam and the President of the Guam Bar Association. The concurrence of a majority of the members present, there being a quorum present, shall be necessary to any action taken by the Judicial Council. Members of the Judicial Council shall be compensated the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each attendance at a Judicial Council meeting, but such compensation shall not exceed more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) in any one calendar month."

Section 19. Members of the Judicial Council shall be compensated as provided in Section 121 of the Code of Civil Procedure from January 1, 1978.

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Section 20. Section 28018 of the Government Code is amended to read:

"Section 28018. Same; fees; expenses; compensation.

The fees required to be paid by applicants for admission to the Bar shall be paid to the Board of Law Examiners and shall be deposited in the Treasury of Guam and shall constitute a separate fund for the reimbursement of expenses of members of the Board of Law Examiners and for the payment of such expenses as are necessary to conduct the Bar examinations. Each member of the Board shall receive the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each attendance at a meeting of the Board, but such compensation shall not apply to more than two (2) meetings in any one (1) calendar month."

Section 21. Members of the Board of Bar Examiners shall be compensated as provided in Section 28018 of the Government Code from March 1, 1978.

Section 22. Section 23354(c) of the Government Code is repealed and reenacted to read:

"(c) In lieu of all other license and registration fees, (1) implements of husbandry and (2) road building and construction equipment other than motor trucks, trailers, semi-trailers and pole or pipe dollies, operated on highways only in moving from one site to another, shall be subject to annual registration. The fee for such registration shall be Three Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$3.50) for each 1,000 pounds of gross weight of said vehicles.

The fees prescribed by this subsection shall not be subject to proration under Section 23358 of this Code."

Section 23. The provisions of Section 22 of this Part shall take effect on April 30, 1979.

# PART SIX

Section 1. Effective July 1, 1978 the following funds are terminated:

a. Parks Fund;

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- b. Workmen's Compensation Special Fund; and
- c. Cooperative Association Revolving Fund.

Section 2. Sections 26012 and 37041 and Article I of Chapter I of Title XIII all of the Government Code are repealed. The balances remaining in the funds repealed by this section shall be transferred to the General Fund and the assets or liabilities of these funds shall be transferred to and become the assets or liabilities of the General Fund. Revenues collected after June 30, 1978 which previously were deposited into these funds shall be deposited into the General Fund beginning July 1, 1978.

Section 3. Section 5 of Public Law 14-105 is repealed.

Section 4. Section 8001 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 8001. (a) The Director, by regulation, shall establish a schedule of fees and a procedure for payment thereof for certain services rendered by the department. Services for which fees shall be charged shall include: escort services for private individuals

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and private agencies except for funeral services; security services for autonomous agencies; traffic control services for private individuals, corporations and associations; security checks on individuals for private agencies; and other services provided by the department to private individuals, clubs, associations and private agencies for which it is reasonable to charge fees.

(b) Fees collected pursuant to this section shall be deposited in the General Fund."

Section 5. The rules and regulations and fee schedule to be adopted pursuant to Section 5 shall be adopted pursuant to the Administrative Adjudication Law and take effect no later than December 31, 1978.

Section 6. Section 11319 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 11319. The Director of Education shall provide for the payment of teachers on a school calendar year basis. The number of pay periods in a school year shall be determined by dividing the number of days in the calendar school year by fourteen (14) days. The gross bi-weekly salary shall be computed by dividing the per annum salary by the number of pay periods in the school calendar. The Director of Education shall provide that teachers may elect to have benefits continued through the summer and other vacation periods; such benefits being life insurance and health insurance plans."

Section 7. Section 4110.4 is added to the Government Code to read:

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"Section 4110.4. Dual Employment Prohibited. No employee of the government of Guam may be employed on a full-time, part-time or contractual basis by more than one department, agency or branch of the government of Guam at any time, except for persons serving as part-time teachers and University of Guam instructors for the Guam Community College and instructors for the University of Guam and the instructors who may be employed during the summer."

Section 8. Subsection (4) is added to Section 6254(a) of the Government Code to read:

"(4) to be billed and held liable for expenditures made in excess of appropriations approved by the Legislature, or in the case of autonomous agencies, in excess of the budget approved by his board or commission."

Section 9. A new Section 6257 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 6257. The liabilities of Certifying
Officers arising from expenditures made in excess of
appropriations may not be removed from the financial
records of the government of Guam unless the Territorial
Auditor for Guam relieves the Certifying Officer of
liability or the Legislature by appropriation corrects
the deficiency. Liabilities of Certifying Officers
resulting from over-expenditure of appropriations,
including over-expenditures committed in FY 1977-shall
be recorded in the Financial Statement of the government
of Guam and the names of the officers shall be clearly

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identified."

Section 10. A new Section 5161 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 5161. All agencies shall submit requests, for supplemental appropriations to the Bureau for its review. The Governor shall submit to the Legislature a comprehensive request for supplemental appropriation on or before January 10 of the fiscal year for which funds are requested. The Legislature shall act on the Governor's request as expeditiously as possible."

Section 11. A new Section 11832.1 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 11832.1. Students who are residents of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands who come to Guam to matriculate at the University of Guam shall be charged resident tuition for their attendance at the University of Guam."

Section 12. Section 4019(a) of the Government Code of Guam is repealed and reenacted to read:

"(a) The Governor is authorized to enter into a contract with one or more public or private companies, authorized to do business in Guam, for group insurance, including but not limited to hospitalization, medical care, life, disability and accident, for all employees or separate groups of employees of the government of Guam."

Section 13. Section 8 of <u>Public Law 14-124</u> is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 8. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Treasury of Guam the sum of Two

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Hundred Ninety-Six Thousand Dollars (\$296,000) to the Guam

Mental Health & Substance Abuse Agency for their operations

and for the establishment and implementation of the

drug abuse program, 'Operation Save a Life'. Further,

notwithstanding any laws, rules or regulations to the contrary,

any overtime services rendered in the performance of

'Operation Save a Life' shall be paid from the funds

appropriated in this section."

### PART SEVEN

## ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS

Section 1. On Reporting Requirements.

- (a) The Director of the Bureau of Budget and Management
  Research shall submit to the Legislature a General
  Fund revenue report not later than the 25th of each month
  beginning July 1978. Said report shall list the
  actual collected revenues along with the actual
  collection for the same time period during the
  previous fiscal year, plus recommendations for
  adjustments of the revenue estimate, if determined
  to be necessary.
- (b) The Director of the Bureau of Budget and Management
  Research shall submit to the Legislature not later than
  the 25th of each month beginning July 1978, a statement
  of General Fund cash receipts and disbursements
  for the month and for the fiscal year to date.
- (c) The Director of Administration shall submit to the Legislature not later than the 25th of the month beginning August 1978, a report of all gifts, advances or loans made between funds. No such

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gifts, advances or loans may be made without legislative authorization, except for repayment of gifts, advances or loans made prior to July 1, 1978. This prohibition extends to cash gifts and temporary loans between funds.

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- (d) The Director of Administration shall submit to the Legislature not later than the 25th of each month beginning August 1978, the Financial Statement of the government of Guam for the preceding month.
- (e) The Director of the Department of Public Works shall submit to the Legislature not later than the 25th of each month beginning August 1978, a capital project status report of all active and inactive projects, including outstanding balances and shall provide explanation and recommendation on projects inactive for six months or more.
- (f) The Executive Director of the Civil Service Commission shall submit not later than the 25th of each month beginning July 1978, a report to the Legislature of any violation of Section 3 of these Administrative Provisions.
- (g) An annual appropriation made to an independent authority or branch shall be divided into four (4) installments which shall be remitted on the first day of each quarter of the appropriate fiscal year. The entities to which this subsection applies are the University of Guam, Guam Memorial Hospital Authority and the Legislature.

Section 2. On Expenditures from Appropriations.

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- (b) Expenditures proposed to be charged against the appropriations made by this Act must have been obligated by a valid purchase order or contract during FY'79, if it is to be carried forward and charged to the appropriations made by this Act. Any unencumbered balance at the end of the Fiscal Year shall revert to the General Fund.
- (c) Expenditures for travel shall be charged to the budget for the Fiscal Year during which such travel is commenced and to the office for which such appropriation was made.
  - The Director of Public Works may charge capital improvement appropriations and job orders for services rendered to these projects in an amount not to exceed 100% of the personnel services appropriations (01) made by this Act for A & E and Construction Administration to supplement the personnel services budget approved for these divisions.
- (e) The Governor shall not transfer funds from an existing agency to any new agency created by him pursuant to Section 9(c) of the Organic Act.
- be responsible for maintenance of the shoulders and traffic islands along the highway of Guam. The Solid Waste Division of the Department shall be responsible for the removal of garbage and trash from designated locations in the various parks and recreation sites.

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The involvement of the Department of Parks and Recreation in these activities shall cease effective July 1, 1978.

Officers of the various agencies shall be based on balances on allotments released by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research. The release of monthly or quarterly allotments by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research from appropriations made under this Act shall be based on anticipated cash receipts so that obligations incurred, both current and past, shall have sufficient cash for their payments. Allotments releases shall not exceed anticipated cash receipts; regular adjustments shall be made by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research to correct releases in excess of actual collections.

Section 3. On Employment and Compensation.

- (a) No department within the Executive Branch shall have more than one deputy director.
- (b) No position authorized by this Act may be filled nor may the work to be performed by the occupant of said position be performed by any person who is not employed as a government employee pursuant to the provisions of Title V of the Government Code.
- (c) Notwithstanding other laws, rules or regulations to the contrary, no promotion or reclassification of any position funded by appropriation of the Legislature may be implemented unless funds are

# specifically appropriated by the Legislature for the purpose.

Section 4. On Legislative Intent.

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The Committee Report and Analysis of the FY'79 appropriations and the Legislative Digest on the Budget shall be evidence of the legislative intent for the allocation and expenditure of the various items of appropriations contained in this Act. The Digest shall constitute the approved budget plan for the agency for the FY'79.

Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from the surplus fund of the General Fund to the Department of Education the sum of Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000) for the express purpose of paying negotiators in the Department of Education for negotiation with the Guam Federation of Teachers during the summer of 1978. This appropriation finances Section 4416 of Public Law 9-240.

Section 6. Section 11973 of the Government Code is repealed and reenacted to read:

"Section 11973. Funds. The Board is authorized to accept private gifts, donations, endowments, grants and other money which may be offered to the Guam Community College even though such gifts, donations, endowments or grants may be subject to reasonable conditions. Such funds as are received shall be deposited into the Fund to be known as the Guam Community College Fund. Expenditures shall be made from the Fund only for the purposes of this Chapter and in accordance with such conditions as may be attached to the gift, donation, endowment or grants. Government of Guam funds appropriated

to the college shall be deposited in the Guam Community College Fund. Expenditure from the Fund shall be made only upon resolution of the Board."

Section 7. Section 42109 is added to the Government Code to read:

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"Section 42109. Effective date. The Office of the Compiler of Laws shall not come into existence until January 1, 1982 unless sooner authorized by the Legislature." Section 8. Section 42110 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 42110. Interim delegation of functions.

Until January 1, 1982, the Guam Law Revision Commission shall have the responsibilities set forth in Section 42102 of this Chapter and shall be vested with the powers set forth in Sections 42103 and 42108 of this Chapter. The Law Revision Commission may delegate any or all of the powers and responsibilities granted by this section to its Executive Secretary. Until January 1, 1982, all references within this Chapter to the Compiler of Laws shall mean the Law Revision Commission."

Section 9. The sum of One Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Seven Dollars (\$122,167) is appropriated from the Legislature Operations Fund to the Law Revision Commission for revision of the Guam Codes and for compiling function.

Section 10. Section 2(a) of Public Law 14-87 is amended to read:

"Section 2. (a) The sum of Two Hundred Thirteen Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Six Dollars (\$213,326) is appropriated from any available surplus in the

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Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the operation of the Office of the Territorial Auditor for calendar year ending December 31, 1978, to be utilized in the following categories:
