AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 69 (b) OF THE CIVIL CODE TO PROVIDE THAT NO PERSON BETWEEN THE AGES OF 16 AND 18 SHALL BE PERMITTED TO MARRY WITHOUT A COURT ORDER AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 69(b) of the Civil Code is amended to read:

"(b) No license shall be issued when either of the applicants therefor is an imbecile, insane as determined by the proper authority or who at the time of making of the application of proof required for said license, is under the influence of intoxicating liquor or narcotic If an applicant is under the age of 18 and has not been previously married, no license shall be issued unless the consent in writing of a parent or guardian of the person under age is presented with the application. A consent must be verified and such consent shall be retained with the application in the files of the Department of Revenue and Taxation. The fact of the consent shall be noted upon the license. In addition to the consent required, no license shall be issued for any person between the age of 16 and 18 unless the marriage of that person has been approved by an order in writing issued from the Superior Court. A license to marry shall not be issued to any person under the age of 16 unless the court authorizes a license to be issued to an applicant who is under sixteen (16) and with a child. No license shall be issued permitting marriage between first cousins, between an adoptive parent and an adoptive child, between a

step-parent and a step-child or between a guardian and a ward unless a written order authorizing such a marriage has been issued by the Superior Court."

Section 2. A new Section 10514.1 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 10514.1. All fees received by the Board under the provisions of this Chapter shall be paid into a special fund known as the 'Contractors Fund' to be used for administration of its duties and enforcement of laws for which it is responsible. Annually, when the amount paid into the Contractors Fund equals the amount appropriated to the Board, any additional receipts during the remainder of the fiscal year shall be paid into the General Fund."

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) from the General Fund to the Contractors Fund for the operation of the Guam Contractors License Board.

Section 4. The following sums are hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the operation of the Public Utilities Commission for the period ending September 30, 1978:

Section 5. Part One, Section 1, Subsection IV, A., 1. d., of Public Law 14-43, as amended by Public Law 14-127, is further amended to read as follows:

"IV. For Community Services

- A. Department of Public Health and Social Services
 - 1. Social Services Division
- d. Contractual Services \$ 704,100".

Section 6. Section 13971 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 13971. Creation of Land Survey Fund. There is within the government of Guam a special fund known as the 'Land Survey Fund'. The Land Transfer Fund is abolished and all moneys therein, except those moneys derived from the program of clearing the fractional lots in the city of Agana, are transferred to the Land Survey Fund. The Land Survey Fund shall be under the administration of the Director of Land Management but no moneys shall be expended therefrom except by appropriation of the Legislature, provided, however, that the Legislature shall not make any appropriation under this section until the Director of Land Management has submitted to the Legislature the systematic program of planned surveys required by Subparagraph (5) of Section 13970 of this Chapter. All proceeds from the sale and lease of public lands, from land permit fees and all other income derived from the operation of the Department of Land Management, including recording fees but excluding the Document Tax proceeds, shall be covered into the Land Survey Fund; provided, however, that the maximum amount of said fund shall not exceed Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$900,000), all such income in excess of said amount to be covered into the General Fund. The Land Survey Fund shall cease and terminate on September 30, 1978 and moneys in said fund at such time shall be covered into the General Fund."

Section 7. There is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Eighteen
Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$18,500) to the Land Survey
Fund.

Section 8. Fees or charges of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority as of the date of the enactment of this law shall not be increased until passage of 60 days after the filing of such fees and charges with the Legislative Secretary in accordance with the Administrative Adjudication Law.

Section 9. Section 16433 of the Government Code of Guam is amended to read:

"Section 16433. Exemption for prior licenses.

Persons engaged in activities requiring licensing under the provisions of this Chapter that were so engaged in Guam prior to May 13, 1977 shall be exempted from the examination requirements hereof."

Section 10. The funds appropriated in Section 3 to the Guam Contractors License Board and in Section 4 to the Public Utilities Commission shall be repaid to the General Fund when said Board or Commission receives fees.

Section 11. The following sums are hereby appropriated from any available balance in the General Fund for the operation of the District Improvement Division of the Department of Public Works for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1979:
