AN ACT TO ADD SECTIONS 21209 AND 21206.1 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO THE PUBLIC UTILITY AGENCY'S AUTHORITY TO BORROW FUNDS AND TO COLLECT ACCOUNTS OR OTHER OBLIGATIONS OWING TO THE AGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. Section 21209 and Section 21206.1 are added to
the Government Code to read:

"Section 21209. Loans to Agency. The Agency is authorized to borrow funds, on a competitive basis, not to exceed, in the aggregate, the total amount of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000), for expansion of its capital plant as required to provide utility services to any agricultural, industrial, commercial or residential sites or developments. Such authority shall be limited to the financing of projects which are approved by the Governor and the Legislature by resolution. The Agency shall dedicate revenue derived from such expanded service In addition, to the repayment of such loans plus interest. repayment of principal and interest of such loans, not to exceed the total amount of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000), shall be guaranteed by the government of Guam."

"Section 21206.1. The Agency may authorize the Attorney General or retain attorneys licensed to practice in Guam and agents or licensed collection agents to collect accounts or other obligations owing to the Agency."
