

Bill No. 546

Introduced by J. M. Rivera

AN ACT TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 39100.2 AND 55015
TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO PROVIDE THAT NO
PRISONER AT THE GUAM PENITENTIARY SHALL BE
ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY EXTRAMURAL PROGRAM
WITHOUT THE EXPRESS ORDER OF THE PAROLE BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Section 55015 is added to the Government
3 Code to read:

4 "Section 55015. Detention of prisoners. Every adult
5 offender serving a sentence of imprisonment imposed by the
6 courts of Guam and other authorized prisoners and other
7 persons placed in the custody of the Director shall not be
8 permitted outside the boundaries of the Guam Penitentiary
9 without the express order of the Parole Board in accordance
10 with Chapter II of Title XXXV of this Code."

11 Section 2. A new Section 39100.2 is added to the Government
12 Code to read:

13 "Section 39100.2. Eligibility for extramural programs.
14 No prisoner under the jurisdiction of the Department of
15 Corrections shall be allowed outside the Guam Penitentiary
16 to participate in such programs as 'Halfway House', 'work
17 release', 'furlough' or any other extramural program whatso-
18 ever, provided that the Board may by uniform rules and
19 regulations provide that a prisoner may leave the penitentiary
20 for medical care and for such other essential reasons. In
21 considering authorization to participate in extramural pro-
22 grams, the provisions of this Chapter dealing with parole,
23 to the extent that they are applicable, shall apply."
