AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO UPGRADE THE TALOFOFO BAY BRIDGE AS A TEMPORARY MEASURE AND AUTHORIZING AN APPROPRIATION FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A PERMANENT BRIDGE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance in the Territorial Highway Fund the sum of Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000) for upgrading of the Talofofo Bay Bridge as a temporary measure pending construction and completion of a new Talofofo Bay Bridge. The above appropriation shall include Seventy Two Thousand Bollars (\$72,000) in Federal grants from the Federal Highway Act. The local Eight Thousand Bollars (\$8,000) matching portion made available under this Act shall not be expended until receipt of the Federal grant is assured. Any unexpended balance of local funds remaining of this appropriation

on December 31, 1977 shall revert to the Territorial Highway Fund.

Section 2. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) from any available source for construction of the new Talofofo Bay Bridge.

Section 3. The Legislature declares that the objects of appropriation in Section 1 of this Act are brought about by an extreme public emergency. In order to accomplish the objects of Section 1 hereof, and for such purpose only, the Director of Public Works shall have the authority to waive Section 10001.6 of the Government Code of Guam in the awarding of a contract or contracts to accomplish the objectives of Section 1 of this Act, provided that in awarding such contracts the Director shall contract only with responsible companies and on such terms as are most favorable to the government given the emergency nature of the contracts involved.

Section 4. Sections 2 and 3 of Public Law 14-5 are amended as follows:

"Section 2. There is appropriated from any available balances in the General Fund to Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority the sum of \$1.0 Million. The sum appropriated by this Section shall be used by the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority to pay its contractor for homes constructed at the GHURA 500 project, and said sum shall be treated as a loan from the General Fund to GHURA repayable from proceeds received from the sales of housing units."

"Section 3. The Board of Commissioners of Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority is directed to create a special fund for the Authority and to deposit it to the proceeds of sales it makes at the GHURA 500 projects. The fund so created shall be reserved by the authority to reimburse the General Fund of the government for the \$1.0 Million appropriated by Section 2 of this Act not later than December 31, 1977."
