


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





Bill No. 296

Introduced by T. V. C. Tanaka

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 25126 AND 19561(c)
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO
SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT COMMERCIAL
PORT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 25126 of the Government Code is amended
3 to read:

4 "Section 25126. Air terminal or Commercial Port licenses.

5 (a) On-sale license. A special license authorizing the sale
6 of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises may
7 be issued to any person granted a concession for that purpose
8 at the air terminal or Commercial Port.

9 (b) Sales to departing passengers. A special license
10 authorizing sale of alcoholic beverages to a departing
11 passenger may be issued to any person granted a concession
12 for that purpose at the air terminal or Commercial Port.
13 Any such sales by distributors to the special licensee for
14 resale to departing passengers shall be exempt from tax to
15 the extent and in the manner provided by Section 19561(c).

16 (c) Licenses authorized by Subsections (a) and (b)
17 shall not be transferable, and their continuance shall be
18 conditioned upon compliance with all terms applicable to
19 operation of the concession as established by terminal or
20 port management, respectively. No concession shall be granted
21 to any person not meeting requirements of law applicable
22 to licensees generally, and its operation shall be subject
23 to compliance with law and regulation by the Board in the
24 same manner as other licensed premises."

1 Section 2. Section 19561(c) of the Government Code is
2 amended to read:

3 "Section 19561(c). That the alcoholic beverages have
4 been exported without Guam or sold for export by the licensee
5 making the report and actually exported from Guam within
6 ninety (90) days from the date of the sale or delivered on
7 board a ship or vessel for store use or ship's consumption,
8 or sold to special licensees authorized under Section 25126
9 to sell alcoholic beverages to departing passengers at the
10 airport or Commercial Port."
