




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 26020 TO THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM TO NAME THE CHALAN PAGO-ORDOT
BASEBALL FIELD THE "JOSE U. ATOIGUE MEMORIAL
PARK".

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 26020 is hereby added to the Government
3 Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 26020. Jose U. Atoigue Memorial Park. The
5 Legislature finds that many of the younger generation are
6 unfamiliar with the athletic feats and accomplishments of
7 their fathers and grandfathers, particularly those baseball
8 players who performed so admirably in those halcyon days
9 prior to the Second World War. Accordingly, the Legislature
10 deems it appropriate to forever memorialize these athletic
11 heroes by naming baseball fields and other public recreational
12 areas after them in commemoration of their contributions to
13 island sport. Jose U. Atoigue was famous throughout the
14 island as probably the best third baseman who ever played on
15 Guam at least before the Second World War. Being a resident
16 of Chalan Pago, the Legislature therefore concludes that
17 naming the ball field there for him would be an appropriate
18 and proper recognition of his contributions to baseball and
19 to the community. Accordingly, the public baseball field in
20 the municiplaity of Chalan Pago-Ordot is hereby renamed the
21 'Jose U. Atoigue Memorial Park'."
