AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25314 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO EXTENDING THE TIME FOR OFF-SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 25314 of the Government Code is amended to read:

"Section 25314. Same: Off-sale. An off-sale licensee shall not sell alcoholic beverages between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. of any day."

Section 2. The sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) is appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Vocational Rehabilitation to fund certain training programs for personnel who will manage the work activity center for developmentally disabled persons.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000) to the Guam Constitutional Convention for legal services.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the Territorial Highway Fund the sum of Twenty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$26,500) to include both Federal (\$23,850) and (\$2,650) local funds under the Safer Roads Demonstration Program for the design and installation of an adequate signals system including minor grading and paving at the intersection of Routes 4 and 4A in Talofofo.

Section 5. The balances in the following accounts appearing in the Government of Guam Financial Statements are hereby reverted to the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to satisfy the appropriations made by Sections 2 and 3 of this Act and to close the accounts: 1. Construction and Improvement of Drainage Systems in Merizo, Asan, Piti, Anigua, Agana Heights and Inarajan 23,048 7109 Construction and Improvement of 2. 7173 Drainage System Dededo 37,876 3. Paasan Avenue 7176 44,788 Section 6. Section 81 of the Code of Civil Procedure is hereby amended to read as follows: "Section 81. Composition of Court. The Superior Court shall consist of a presiding judge and such additional judges as may be necessary for the proper dispatch of the business of the court. The annual salary of the presiding judge shall be Thirty Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$30,500) and the annual salary of the other judges shall be Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000)." Section 7. Section 1 of this Act shall become effective

October 1, 1977. Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of this Act shall

become effective upon enactment into law.
