


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25314 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO EXTENDING
THE TIME FOR OFF-SALE OF ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 25314 of the Government Code is amended
3 to read:

4 "Section 25314. Same: Off-sale. An off-sale
5 licensee shall not sell alcoholic beverages between the hours
6 of 2:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. of any day."

7 Section 2. The sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000)
8 is appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated
9 Surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Vocational
10 Rehabilitation to fund certain training programs for personnel
11 who will manage the work activity center for developmentally
12 disabled persons.

13 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available
14 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
15 sum of Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000) to the Guam
16 Constitutional Convention for legal services.

17 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available
18 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the Territorial Highway
19 Fund the sum of Twenty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$26,500)
20 to include both Federal (\$23,850) and (\$2,650) local funds under
21 the Safer Roads Demonstration Program for the design and installa-
22 tion of an adequate signals system including minor grading and
23 paving at the intersection of Routes 4 and 4A in Talofof.

1 Section 5. The balances in the following accounts appearing
2 in the Government of Guam Financial Statements are hereby re-
3 verted to the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to
4 satisfy the appropriations made by Sections 2 and 3 of this Act
5 and to close the accounts:

- 6 1. Construction and Improvement of
7 Drainage Systems in Merizo, Asan,
8 Piti, Anigua, Agana Heights and
9 Inarajan 7109 \$ 23,048
- 10 2. Construction and Improvement of
11 Drainage System Dededo 7173 37,876
- 12 3. Paasan Avenue 7176 44,788

13 Section 6. Section 81 of the Code of Civil Procedure is
14 hereby amended to read as follows:

15 "Section 81. Composition of Court. The Superior Court
16 shall consist of a presiding judge and such additional judges as
17 may be necessary for the proper dispatch of the business of the
18 court. The annual salary of the presiding judge shall be Thirty
19 Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$30,500) and the annual salary of
20 the other judges shall be Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000)."

21 Section 7. Section 1 of this Act shall become effective
22 October 1, 1977. Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of this Act shall
23 become effective upon enactment into law.
