

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF THREE HUNDRED  
TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS TO THE GOVERNMENT  
CLAIMS FUND AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the  
3 Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Three Hundred Twenty  
4 Five Thousand Dollars (\$325,000) to the Government Claims Fund.

5 Section 2. The balances in the following accounts appearing in the  
6 Government of Guam Financial Statements are hereby reverted to the  
7 Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to satisfy the appropriation  
8 made by Section 1 of this Act and to close the accounts:

10 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus  
 11 of the General Fund the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) reverted  
 12 under Section 3 of this Act for the design and construction of restroom  
 13 facilities for Chalan Pago-Ordot baseball field.

14 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus  
 15 of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred Thirty Five Thousand Dollars  
 16 (\$135,000.00) reverted under Section 3 of this Act for the design and  
 17 construction of a multi-purpose sportsfield consisting of baseball, football,  
 18 and soccer fields at Tamuning on government-owned land located between Lyndon

- 19 B. Johnson School and Tamuning Elementary School to be allocated as follows:
- 20 A. Project design and administration \$ 15,000
  - 21 B. Filling, grading, levelling, and drainage facilities 40,000
  - 22 C. Lighting 50,000
  - 23 D. Fencing, back stop, dug outs, goal posts 30,000

24 Section 6. Sections 3, 4 and 5 shall be immediately effective upon its  
 25 enactment into law.
