




AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE  
TERRITORIAL HIGHWAY FUND TO SUPPLEMENT PRIOR  
APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF TWO  
BRIDGES ALONG ROUTE 4 IN INARAJAN.

1           WHEREAS, the Legislature had by Public Law 12-95, 12-198  
2           and 13-142 appropriated Nine Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Dollars  
3           (\$964,000) for the construction of bridges in the municipality  
4           of Inarajan; and

5           WHEREAS, the lowest bidder requires One Million One Hundred  
6           Twelve Thousand Five Hundred Four Dollars (\$1,112,504) to  
7           undertake the project; and

8           WHEREAS, an additional appropriation of One Hundred Forty-  
9           Eight Thousand Five Hundred Four Dollars (\$148,504) would be  
10          needed to award the contract to the lowest bidder; and



1 (b) Section 3002.1 of the Government Code of Guam is  
2 hereby amended to read:

3 Section 3002.1. Same: government vehicles. No  
4 government vehicle, whether government-owned or leased,  
5 shall be used for other than official purposes. No such  
6 vehicle shall be used for the transportation of any govern-  
7 ment officer or employee between his place of abode and  
8 place of employment except in connection with official  
9 duties for the convenience of the government. Subject  
10 to the limitations imposed herein, the Governor by  
11 Executive Order, the Legislature through its Committee on  
12 Rules, and the Judicial Council by rule, shall prescribe  
13 the use of government vehicles assigned respectively to the  
14 Executive Branch, Legislative Branch, and Judicial Branch,  
15 and shall take appropriate action to discipline any member  
16 of their respective branches who shall violate this section.  
17 Such action may be by way of administrative fine, suspension,  
18 or removal, and in the case of members of the classified  
19 service shall be taken pursuant to the Personnel Law. Such  
20 action shall not preclude prosecution for any criminal  
21 offense. The provisions of this section shall not apply  
22 to any vehicle assigned for the use of the Governor, the  
23 Speaker of the Legislature, or the Secretary of Guam."

24 Section 4. Section 3(b) foregoing shall become effective  
25 upon the change of the incumbent judge of the District Court  
26 of Guam.
