AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 22006 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO FEES FOR NOTARY PUBLIC SERVICES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 22006 of the Government Code is amended to read:

"Section 22006. Same: fees. Subject to the provisions contained in this section, every Notary Public shall be entitled to demand and receive the following fees:

- (a) For taking acknowledgment or proof of a deed or other instrument, to include the seal and writing of the certificate: for the first two signatures, Three Dollars (\$3.00) each, and for each additional signature, One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50).
- (b) For administering an oath or affirmation, Three Dollars (\$3.00).
- (c) For every certificate, to include writing the same, and the seal, Three Dollars (\$3.00).

Provided, however, that in no event may a Notary Public who is an employee of the government demand or receive any fee or compensation of any kind for performing any duty of a Notary Public during normal hours of work in his employment by the government."

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500) to the Department of Public Safety for the purpose of implementing a Heroin Awareness Media Project. Said amount shall be used as the local matching share for Federal LEAA federal funds of Thirty-One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$31,500).
