

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 22006 OF THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO FEES FOR  
NOTARY PUBLIC SERVICES AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 22006 of the Government Code is amended  
3 to read:

4 "Section 22006. Same: fees. Subject to the provisions  
5 contained in this section, every Notary Public shall be  
6 entitled to demand and receive the following fees:

7 (a) For taking acknowledgment or proof of a  
8 deed or other instrument, to include the seal and  
9 writing of the certificate: for the first two signa-  
10 tures, Three Dollars (\$3.00) each, and for each  
11 additional signature, One Dollar and Fifty Cents  
12 (\$1.50).

13 (b) For administering an oath or affirmation,  
14 Three Dollars (\$3.00).

15 (c) For every certificate, to include writing the  
16 same, and the seal, Three Dollars (\$3.00).

1            Provided, however, that in no event may a Notary Public  
2 who is an employee of the government demand or receive any  
3 fee or compensation of any kind for performing any duty of  
4 a Notary Public during normal hours of work in his employ-  
5 ment by the government."

6            Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the Unappro-  
7 priated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Three Thousand  
8 Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500) to the Department of Public Safety  
9 for the purpose of implementing a Heroin Awareness Media Pro-  
10 ject. Said amount shall be used as the local matching share for  
11 Federal LEAA federal funds of Thirty-One Thousand Five Hundred  
12 Dollars (\$31,500).
